

MEADOWLARK EQUESTRIAN CENTER BARN RULES

Rider and Horse Names: _____

Please read and initial each of the following to signify your understanding and agreement to comply to rule.

- _____ When entering and exiting the driveway, be respectful of riders and horses and drive slowly.
(There is a blind spot, and other drivers may not be readily apparent.)
- _____ **NO SMOKING ANYWHERE ON PROPERTY**
- _____ ALL lights and electronics must be turned off **each time** before exiting the barn.
- _____ Clean and sanitize everything you come in contact with, including gates, light switches, etc.
- _____ Empty all muck buckets/wheelbarrows after use.
- _____ **If your horse poops anywhere on the property apart from their assigned stall or on the trails, you must clean it up. Manure in arenas may be put in wheelbarrows.**
- _____ No rider may be mounted inside any building, apart from the indoor riding arena.
- _____ **Riders must wear ASTM/SEI certified helmets at all times** while mounted. NO exceptions.
- _____ Horses out grazing must be supervised at all times.
- _____ **Lunging may not be done in close proximity to mounted riders, due to safety concerns.**
- _____ If there are other riders or lessons in an arena, wait respectfully for a convenient time to pass through their workspace or walk quietly around them, practicing safe social distancing.
- _____ Any equipment used in the indoor arena must be SANITIZED, and put back into storage when you're finished. Jumps be left up in non-dressage area of the OUTDOOR arena only.
- _____ If you find it open, leave it open; if you find it closed, leave it closed. This includes: gates, arena doors, barn doors, stall doors and rotational pasture fencing.
- _____ Arena sprinklers may **not** be used by anyone other than management.
- _____ **Visitors must be under supervision, and practice social distancing at all times.**
- _____ **Do not feed or give treats to horses on the property without permission at any time.**
- _____ Food or food-related garbage must be kept out of reach of raccoons and opossums.
- _____ All injuries, accidents and damages to horses, riders or personal property on the Stable property must be immediately brought to management attention.
- _____ **No outside instructors or trainers may work with riders/horses without expressed permission from management.**
- _____ All visiting instructors/trainers must be previously approved and insured, and must have Meadowlark Equestrian Center, LLC listed as an additionally insured party on insurance.
- _____ **All visitors are to be courteous to others. If an issue should arise, contact must be made to the management, to help us all avoid drama.**
- _____ No rider may be mounted on a horse under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- _____ **All visitors** (including yourself, riders, friends, and family) must fill out visitor waiver form (www.MeadowlarkEquestrianCenter.com/visitorwaiver.pdf) and a Meadowlark Covid-19 Questionnaire (www.MeadowlarkEquestrianCenter.com/covidquestionnaire.html) before visiting the farm.
- _____ Visitor certifies that they are of sound mind and not suffering from shock or under the influence of alcohol, drugs, intoxicants or cognitive impairments.
- _____ Visitor has read and understood this entire document and agrees to abide by these rules.
