- August 17th (Sunday) Return to Troop 78 Cabin

Merit Badge & Training (Additional training may be required at the trip leader's discretion)

- Swimming (Required)
- Canoeing (Required)
- First Aid (Required)
- Life Savings (Recommended)
- Wilderness First Aid (Recommended) Adult-only

Crew Information (Final routes and distances will be finalized by Summer camp)

- Lake Crew 1 & 2 This crew is for Scouts with limited experience with long-distance canoeing and will be required to do moderate portages with multiple 2-3 day trips with resupply at base camp between trips.
- **River Crew 1 & 2** This crew is for Scouts who have the capability of canoeing long distances and the ability for backcountry camping with significant canoeing & portaging required.
