AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE WEIGHT LIMITS FOR TRUCKS AND OTHER VEHICULAR EQUIPMENT OPERATING ON THE STREETS OF LAKEVIEW HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, the streets in the city are being unduly damaged by use thereof by heavy trucks and other equipment to the extent that proper maintenance of said streets is impractical;

NOW, THEREFORE, it be ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lakeview Heights, Kentucky:

SECTION 1: That it shall be unlawful for any truck, vehicle, or equipment exceeding nine (9) tons or eighteen thousand (18,000) pounds including the vehicle and load, to use, enter upon, or travel any of the streets in the City, except that moving vans carrying the usual household furnishings type load, and garbage pick-up vehicles shall be permitted to carry their normal loads. Ready-mix concrete vehicles shall be permitted to haul a maximum of three (3) cubic yards of material per load. Any other exceptions shall require special permission from the City Commission.

SECTION 2: Any person, firm, or corporation in violation of this Ordinance and upon conviction, shall be fined not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$200.00 Each trip over said streets shall constitute a separate offense. In addition to the fine, any person, firm or corporation in violation of this Ordinance shall be required to pay the costs to repair any damages done to the streets by his vehicles.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
