Robert Daniel Quinn, 79, lifelong Caseville resident, died Wednesday, July 20, 2005, at St. Mary's Hospital in Saginaw of injuries received in a car accident on July 11, 2005. Bob was born September 24, 1925 in Caseville to the late Daniel and Mary (Corbett) Quinn. He graduated from Pigeon High School in 1943. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II. After the war, he worked as a trooper for the Michigan State Police and then as a deputy for the Huron County Sheriff's Office until 1963. He married Mary Kathleen Cherry in 1954 in Carlton. In 1963, he began working as a mail carrier for the U.S. Post Office in Caseville, retiring in 1987. Bob was a member of St. Roch Catholic Church, Caseville American Legion, and the Caseville Historical Society. He was a former member of the Caseville Eagles, Caseville Optomists, Caseville Kiwanis, and the Huron County Jury Commission. He enjoyed boating and diving, participating in community and family activities, and watching local and family sports. Bob is survived by his wife of 51 years, Mary K.; sons, Daniel and his wife, Rhonda, of Caseville, Mark and his wife, Karen, of Naperville, Illinois, and Timothy, of Caseville; grandchildren, Katherine, Shawn, Kyle, Lauren, Matthew, Ryan, Kristen and Kevin; and a sister, Delores Stefan, of Las Vegas, Nevada. Bob was preceded in death by his daughter, Mary Theresa "Teri"; brother, James; and sister, Doris Marshall. A Funeral Mass will be at 10 a.m. on Monday, July 25, 2005, at St. Roch Catholic Church, Fr. Ken Yaroch presiding. Burial with military honors will be at St. Roch Cemetery. Visitation will be from 2 to 8 p.m. on Saturday and noon to 6 p.m. on Sunday at the Champagne Funeral Chapel of Caseville and from 9 a.m. on Monday until the time of Mass at the church.
