

DEPARTMENT 13 - Vegetables

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Rules:

1. In selecting vegetables for exhibition, choose the specimens that would bring the highest market price. If possible, do not mix varieties.
2. The following factors will be used in judging:
 - a. Trueness of variety type. Pick specimens from one variety.
 - b. Uniformity of shape, size and color
3. Pick specimens of similar maturity
4. Select specimens that are perfect and show no blemishes (dirt, disease, mechanical damage, pest damage)
5. There should not be any stems on the tomatoes.
6. Herbs- 3 stems must be entered in your jar .Except Chives
7. Leave short stems on Peppers and Squash
8. Leave husks on corn
9. Best Prepared Dish featuring a vegetable, **classes 288 in OPEN and 300 in Youth**: please include a copy of the recipe - Dish must be prepared by exhibitor but ingredients may be purchased (**cannot require refrigeration or heating**)
10. Read the Premium material carefully, following all rules and regulations. If an entry calls for 5 specimens, be sure to exhibit that number. Your entry will be disqualified if the correct number of specimens are not entered.
11. All entries should be locally grown by the exhibitor. Under no circumstance should entries be purchased or obtained from another grower.
12. Please note: a Youth Division has been added for a limited number of vegetables. Youth is defined as anyone 18 or under. Exhibitors of any age can enter the Open Categories.
13. **ALL ENTIRES MUST BE PICKED UP BY 5PM ON SUNDAY OR THEY WILL BE DONATED TO A LOCAL FOOD PANTRY (IF EDIBLE)**
