Dear Parents/Guardians and Students,

The Career Center's Joint Operating Committee voted to return to a five day a week instructional model for all students. This will begin on Monday, February 1, 2021.

Students will return to the pre-hybrid 'in-person' schedule, Monday through Friday, as follows:

Morning Session:

Students and staff must be vigilant in following all of the mitigation guidelines outlined in our Health & Safety Plan, which are listed below. These follow Department of Health and Pennsylvania Department of Education guidelines to lessen and/or eliminate the possible transmission of COVID-19.

Upon returning to school, the following COVID-19 mitigation requirements remain in place:

- Face coverings, *which cover the mouth and nose*, are to be worn at all times when in the school
 - Face shields **must** cover the nose and mouth and extend below the chin and to the ears, and leave no exposed gap between the forehead and the shield's headpiece.
- Maintain a six foot social distance
- Frequent hand washing and/or hand sanitizing
- Disinfection of frequently touched areas between the morning & afternoon sessions and between use of shared items within the class/shop
- Use the symptom COVID-19 Symptom Screening Tool (located on the home page of clarioncte.org) each day before coming to school. If you have symptoms of COVID-19 such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, nasal congestion etc., **do not** come to school. Students with symptoms at school will be sent home.
- If you have been advised by the Department of Health or a medical professional to quarantine or isolate at home, **do not** come to school. Circumstances where this would occur would be if you were a contact of a positive COVID-19 person or have tested positive for COVID-19.
- If you have been tested for COVID-19 and are awaiting results, **do not** come to school until you have received your results and have been advised that you are permitted to return to school.
- If you have been exposed to a positive COVID-19 person, **do not** come to school.
