## **The 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Vancouver Wine & Jazz Festival is August 25, 26, 27, 2017.**

The Festival celebrates the best in jazz, fine arts & crafts, wine and local cuisine. It is *"...the largest festival of its kind in the Pacific Northwest..."* (KATU 2, Portland, OR). The Festival is the #1 arts event in Southwest Washington and tens of thousands of visitors from 23 states and Canada have attended since 1998. Hundreds of Artists and Crafters have participated and sold your art at the Festival for many years. It is good to know that the Festival has been an opportunity for so many professionals to successfully sell their art.

Enclosed is a 2017 Fine Artist & Crafter Application. We give first priority to our **RETURNING Artists/Crafters** to reserve their booth space before we open the Festival up to new artists. ### **ARTIST & CRAFTER INFORMATION**

- **BOOTH FEE:** The price is \$375 for a single booth and \$600 for a double booth. If you pay by credit card there is an additional 4% processing fee. There is no processing fee if you pay by check.
- **Artist Sales:** 100% of your sales go to you! We do not take a percentage of sales. Booth Fees pay for Festival advertising, marketing and promotion—which brings more qualified buyers to YOU.
- **Location, Artist Space & Electricity:** Esther Short Park, in Vancouver, WA. A Single Artist Space is 10 X 10 feet and a Double Space is 10 X 20 feet. Canopies are not provided. Electricity is included - no extra cost!
- **Jurying of Art:** The Festival is a juried event for professional Artists and Crafters. First-time Artists **MUST** submit a website link of your art; or submit photos or a CD/DVD with your Application demonstrating the quality of your art. The Festival does not accept imports or art from co-ops or secondary parties.
- **Limited Spaces:** We limit the artist / crafter spaces to a maximum of 40 artists.
- **HOW TO APPLY:** Fill out the Artist Application. Return the completed Application **WITH** your Booth Fee. Or, email your completed Application to [info@vancouverwinejazz.com](mailto:info@vancouverwinejazz.com) and purchase your booth fee online by clicking the Booth Fee button. If you are not accepted, your booth fee is refunded.
