

# Fabric Rag Wreath

We will be using strips of fabric that will be tied to a wire wreath frame to create a beautiful fabric wreath that can be used for any season. This project could be a great way to use up some of your scraps of fabric and it won't even require your sewing machine.

## Materials and Supplies needed:

- **Wire wreath frame** – I used 18" Frame
  - o Since these may be hard to find this time of year, I have 15 of the 18" wire wreath frames available to be purchased at \$5 each (first come first serve)
- **About 2.5 yards of fabric total (9 in long strips)** – I used 7 fabrics (less than ½ yard of each)
  - o I would recommend not using only 6 or 3 colors (5 or 7 seem to work great)
  - o We will be cutting them in 1 in strips by 9 in long. Due to time, please bring a few pieces already cut in each color.
- **Scissors & Ruler OR**
  - o **Rotary Cutter & Cutting Mat**
  - o Only if you are planning to cut your strips at workshop.
