COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS

The Barnstable Comedy Club remains committed to the health and safety of our community. As such, BCC is implementing safety measures to ensure a safe and enjoyable theater going experience for our patrons, staff, volunteers, and artists. BCC adheres to all requirements and regulations set forth by the State of Massachusetts and the CDC including but not limited to; observing social distancing, limited capacity and requiring masks or facial coverings.

As of August 1, 2021, masks will be encouraged but no longer required for our vaccinated patrons. <u>Unvaccinated patrons</u>, <u>however</u>, <u>must continue to wear a mask indoors for the entire performance</u>, in accordance with the state mandate.

If you are feeling sick, we encourage you NOT to attend the performance and to call the Box Office to reschedule your tickets for a later date.

Hand Sanitizer stations have been conveniently placed at key points in the theater for continued disinfecting and cleanliness.

Digital playbills may be viewed online to reduce exchange of printed materials.

We continue to listen, learn and evolve to keep our theater a comfortable and safe environment for our patrons, artists and staff. Cast and crew members, staff, and patrons must not have any of the following new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19
