SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES
 TUESDAY, OCTOBER 01, 2024, 6:30 P.M.

Attendance: Selectmen: Jim Dolloff, Dale Miner, Robert Flint as well as members of the Public.

The Regularly scheduled Select Board Meeting was called to order after the conclusion of Public Hearings for General Assistance and Road Closures for Winter Maintenance.


1. Review/ Approve - September 17th, 2024, minutes. Minutes unavailable. Review and approval at next meeting.
2. Review/ Approve – October 1st, 2024, warrant.
 Dale Miner moved to accept and approve the October 01st, 2024, warrant. Robert Flint seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept the warrant.
3. **General Assistance Ordinance:** Robert Flint moved to approve the General Assistance Ordinance (The Maine Municipal Association’s model and appendices provided by Cumberland County General Assistance Program for the Town of Baldwin). Dale Miner seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 in favor.
4. **Road Closures for Winter Maintenance:** Dale Miner moved to approve the Road Closures for Winter Maintenance as written for 2024-2025 season. Robert Flint seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 in favor.
 - Robert Flint noted that a Power Point representative came out to the Town Office and reviewed the planned location of the generator. Steve Thorne Jr. is to get eight-by-eight boards and gravel for its placement. A revised estimate is pending, reflecting a change in transfer switch and muffler connector.
 - Jim Dolloff stated that he had someone interested in buying the old piano located in the Community Center. The Selectmen agreed to a price of \$50.00.
 - Dale Miner to amend/insert wording in Cannabis Ordinance for Public Notice and Special Town Meeting Warrant article.




Public Question and Comment:
