Board of Trustees VILLAGE OF MILLERTON Public Hearing – Budget 2020-2021 April 15, 2020

Public Hearing – Budget 2020-2021

Motion was made by Trustee Hartzog to open the Public Hearing for the 2020-2021 Budget at 7:05 PM, seconded by Deputy Mayor Najdek, all five (5) members in attendance approved and motion passed.

Treasurer Stephany Eisermann gave an overview, summary of the budget for the 2020-2021 fiscal year of the Village of Millerton. She stated that the tax rate for this year would stay the same and that some lines in the budget would be decreased.

Clerk Report

A new sign for the Village Hall location at 5933 N. Elm Avenue was presented to the board along with a price. *Motion* was made by Trustee Schultz to allow the purchase of the new sign by Ghi Sign at the cost of \$990 as long as the dimensions proposed in sketch are within the Village sign code limits, seconded by Trustee Hartzog, all five (5) members in attendance approved and motion passed. Clerk Kilmer will check with Building Inspector Ken McLaughlin to make sure that the sign will be at the right dimensions.
