From the Desk of the Administrator:

I think "humility" gets a bad rap and is often misunderstood. We may have been taught that being humble means to not be proud of any of our accomplishments. And yet at the same time, those who are humble are sometimes seen as being submissive or being doormats for others. Rather, I think humility is simply about being real, being grounded, and knowing that we are the created ones, not the Creator. The Latin words humus (soil/earth) and homo (human being) have a common derivation, from which we also get the word "humble". On Ash Wednesday we are reminded of exactly that. That we are dust and to dust we will return. This is not a bad thing. It is the simple knowledge that we are not God. How freeing that is! We humble human beings will do great things and we will make many mistakes. We will need to rely on our God and we will need to rely on each other. We each have God given gifts that we can

proudly use for the good of others. That is why God made us with such diverse talents, abilities and understandings so that together we have what we need to live together on and with this incredible world. Humility is about remembering who we are and whose we are, and being that person to the best of our ability for the glory of the One who made us.

WALKING WITH THE SPIRIT — "Behold, I am Doing Something New!"






