- Dale passed around a copy of the bill for the helicopter safety requirements the Honorable Joe Negus is introducing to Congress and a copy of the Chapters endorsement of the Bill sent this month.

- Greg Mann indicated that Buckley AFB has many recreational items available.
- George Mayl said the VA can do an extensive genealogy evaluation of blood.
