M2L is committed to the identification of environmental aspects of its activities and services and minimising the environmental impact to its railway and utility clients throughout their lifecycle. These services include the supply of road transport services to the rail and utilities industries and all other clients.

M2L aim to:

- Ensure sustainable procurement, through minimising carbon emissions, and promoting ethical sourcing practices. Minimising our environmental impact and promoting sustainability in all aspects of our business operations
- M2L have an anti-idling policy, compliant with FORS (Freight Operators Recognition Scheme)
- M2L actively engage with Fuelcard Services and Cool Earth to help reduce Global Carbon Emissions and contribute towards planting of trees. We utilize the "Co2 count service offered."
- Continually improve its environmental performance through the development and achievement of objectives and targets.
- Prevent pollution of the environment and have procedures in place to deal with environmental accidents/incidents and company responsibilities. (See EP01 Environmental Assessment Procedure for details)
- Comply with all relevant environmental legislation and Network Rail Standards.
- Improve and integrate, where possible, environmental management into our business system.
- Ensure that effective relationships are maintained with industry partners, regulatory bodies and other interested parties.
- Examine our use of resources, plant, and materials, and seek to minimise use and recycle or reuse waste where practicable.
- Involve all staff in the promotion of M2L attitude to the environment, through environmental awareness, training and guidance.
- Set and monitor environmental objectives and targets each year.
