The Bible declares that the blood of Jesus has conquered the power and consequence of sin.

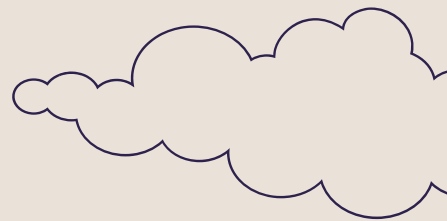
How do you affirm this truth?
