### 10 Things You Should Know About Pentecost Sunday

Pentecost Sunday falls this year on June 9<sup>th</sup>. But many people, including Christians, may not know why the day is special or what is celebrated. Unlike Easter and Christmas, when colorful eggs, Easter bunnies, Christmas trees and Santa Claus are harbingers of the upcoming Christian holidays, there are no such social markers by secular society ahead of Pentecost. For those who need a quick and basic understanding of what Pentecost Sunday is, below is listed 10 things you should know about the holiday.

- 1. Pentecost Sunday marks the day when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles.
- 2. Pentecost Sunday occurs 50 days after Easter.
- 3. The Bible records the Pentecost in Acts 2:1-13.
- 4. Pentecost comes 10 days after the Ascension of Jesus Christ.
- 5. Pentecost is also known as "the birthday of the Church".
- 6. Pentecost fulfills Jesus' promise to send the "Counselor" and "Spirit of Truth" in John 16-5-15.
- 7. Pentecost launches the large-scale spreading of the Gospel after Jesus' ascension. Acts 2:41 records that after Peter spoke to the crowd after receiving the Holy Spirit, some 3,000 people were baptized.
- 8. The Pentecostal movement derives its name from the New Testament event in Acts 2.
- 9. Jews also celebrate Pentecost, but not for the same reason as Christians. The celebration by Jews of Pentecost is to observe God giving the Ten Commandments on Mount Sinai 50 days after the Exodus. The Pentecost in Jewish tradition takes place 50 days after Passover.
- 10. In Western Churches, Pentecost is usually represented with the color red, which symbolizes the fire of the Holy Spirit.







Greetings to all,

As I look out my office window I see something of a parable teaching Christ is offering me today. I think I will call it the Parable of the Bird Feeder.

As Jesus speaks I look and I see a bird feeder with sunflower seeds and a blanket of what some would call weeds taking over the little church garden next to my office window. My mind goes to Matthew 13:24-30 the story of the weeds.

When I see the garden I see a bunch of weeds but then I think about what is a weed? A weed can be simply something you did not plant but it comes up on its own. To a farmer it could simply be some corn growing in his wheat field. Both are useful plants but since they did not plant corn in the field it is now a weed.

There are many plants in this little garden space some have been planted and some were not but they are all there. I can also imagine that latter this summer there may be some sunflowers growing there as well as the birds have scattered the seeds as they visit the feeder.

So as Jesus is talking about all of this all I can see is a mess that needs more work than I have time to do. Then Jesus makes a point about how this is a picture of the church.

I scratch my head and say what do you mean? Then the idea hits me about what he is talking about.

The bird feeder is just like the church. When it was first put up there was no activity at the feeder. The seed was there but no birds were coming to get anything to eat. It went this way for about two months until a few birds found the feeder then they must have told their friends and as their friend showed up others saw the activity and came to see what was going on.

When they came they found they could receive food for their body and peace of mind that help was available to help them to be feed.

As the activity increased the weeds stated to move in. All around the feeder the ground is being covered with greenery that was never planted and to most it looks like a distraction but too the birds it is not a problem because they can raise above it to find what they need.

So it is with the church, we offer food to the lost soul but we are surrounded by a multitude of distractions that can keep us from finding the food we need. But if we rise up the food is still there. Likewise we can tell our friends of the abundance we know and can help others to find the food they need.

What we see as distractions are really those that have been planted by God around us so we can invite them to come to the feeder. What we see as weeds are useful plants but they are not where they need to be.

As the spring and summer proceed into fall I know the weeds that are now in the garden are going to produce flowers and seeds that the birds will also use and so it is with the distractions in our lives. We can use them as a mission field to grow more Disciples of Christ. Our job is to keep the feeder full and invite any and all to share in what we have found


