Nursing Assistant/Home Health Aide Program

Classes are 9am to 2pm Monday through Friday except for four days of clinical experience which is 8:15am to 2:15pm. Each session is 9 weeks. It is a concentrated course that requires home study as well. Job Readiness, Resume Writing, Customer Service, Alzheimer's, Home Health, Critical Thinking, First Aid, CPR and Nutrition classes are also included. There is a Job Shadow Program available where you can be placed at a local agency in order to increase your experience, improve your resume and your professional portfolio. We also require three computerized courses in the national adult basic education program called Career Ready 101®/ACT KeyTrain® that will improve both career readiness skills and your ability to be hired. No certificates can be issued if these 3 course exams are not passed with a minimum of a BRONZE level of achievement.

- Registration is on a first come, first serve basis as we only take up to 14 students per term.
- You must pass the required 2 hour Writing, CR 101 @ Applied Math & Locating Information screening tests and you must have a clean CORI to be considered.
- Please bring \$10 cash for the test.
- Successful application interviews are also required for those who pass all 3 placement tests.

You will learn to communicate effectively with staff and residents, assist residents with their daily activities and monitor vital signs. The lessons provide detailed instruction with an emphasis on resident rights, sound ethics & safety and are a preparation for the Massachusetts Nurse Aide Competency Evaluation. We offer certificates in CPR, Home Health, First Aid, Nutrition, and Nursing Assistant Course Completion & Career Readiness. **You must pass all 3 ACT Career Readiness Exams in order to graduate.** We also have a Job Shadow Program. Successful course completion prepares you to take the state test for certification. Once certified by the state, you are a CNA.*
