

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO
ORDINANCE O-2016-25**

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF KEVIN BARKLEY AS POLICE SERGEANT FOR THE AMELIA VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Amelia Village has a vacancy in its Police Department for a sergeant, and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of the Police Chief, the Mayor desires to appoint Kevin Barkley to fill the vacancy as a sergeant in the Amelia Village Police Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. Based on the Police Chief's recommendation, the Mayor does hereby appoint Kevin Barkley to fill the vacant position of sergeant in the Amelia Village Police Department, effective July 11, 2016.

SECTION II. Village Council does hereby confirm the Mayor's probationary appointment.

SECTION III. Kevin Barkley shall serve a probationary period of six months, at such time the Mayor with the concurrence of Village Council shall remove him from the position or upon successful completion of the probationary period appoint him as a permanent sergeant with the Amelia Village Police Department. Mr. Barkley shall be promoted to the position of police sergeant and his beginning salary shall be set at Nineteen and 29/100 dollars (\$19.29) per hour during the employee's probationary period. This pay increase shall be effective July 11, 2016.

SECTION IV. After Mr. Barkley's successful completion of the probationary period, and his appointment to permanent sergeant with the Amelia Village Police Department his pay shall be increased to Nineteen and 54/100 dollars (\$19.54) per hour.

SECTION V. That the Amelia Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION VI. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the Police Department of Amelia Village has several vacant positions and this appointment will allow the Village to provide the necessary police protection to the citizens of the Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

D. Campbell moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.
