The Second Scrutiny – The Man Born Blind

The focus in the Gospel and the Second Reading is turning from darkness to light, as symbolized in the healing of the man born blind. Through examination of conscience in the light of God's Word, it will lead to enlightenment.

In this Second Scrutiny, the Elect have already been enlightened to some degree. Lent is a time when this is intensified for them, and also for us who are already Catholic. We still need to be enlightened, to have our own patterns of sin and blindness revealed to us, and to grow in God's truth. The important teaching is about who Jesus is: "I am the light of the world." It also looks forward to the enlightenment celebrated in Easter and baptism.
