**Did you know...?**

Saint Olaf was the son of Harold Grenske, King of Norway. Olaf joined the Vikings and spent eight years in piracy before returning to Norway to become king in 1015AD. During his travels he was converted to Christianity. When he returned to Norway he brought with him a Catholic Bishop and a number of Priests and Monks to spread the Gospel. He tried to introduce Christianity by force and was eventually driven from the country. He died in battle in 1030. Because of the miracles reported at the River Nid, where he died, he was venerated as a martyr and Saint. He is the Patron Saint of Norway and his feast day is July 29. *Saint Olaf. Pray for Us!*
