Thank you to Ron Gold of Marketing Works for inviting us on the show.







#### Room 64 is Learning About Dental Hygiene





#### Alumni News—Samantha Lademann



Recently, a young woman who attended Little Village in the early 80's reconnected with us. Samantha Lademann, who has Cerebral Palsy, graduated from Little Village in 1987.

Samantha has recently gone through major orthopedic surgery and lost

over 100 pounds. She is now walking independently without the aide of any assistive device. She fondly recalls her days at Little Village. "I have very clear memories of coming into her (Dr. Barbara Feingold's) office on a "tummy board" (for flexing pelvic adductors) and being allowed to sit in her fancy desk chair and spin around in it as a reward for doing well in PT." She remembers her Physical Therapist Chris Capobianco and Teacher Joyce Blau (who are both still working at Little Village).

Samantha wanted to share her story "to inspire someone else and perhaps provide hope to another patient be it another adult, a teen, or even the parents of a little one recently diagnosed w/ CP who might be wonder-

ing what the future could hold for their child years down the line. I wanted them to know there is hope and help out there and that a Cerebral Palsy diagnosis is not the end of the world - while every case is different, their child can still go on to have a great and fulfilling life... My work isn't done. I know I still have work to do but I WILL get there of that I'm certain. Sure, some days are harder than others and it's definitely not always easy but I've made the conscious choice to "work for it". I will not be a victim of Cerebral Palsy, RSD circumstances or anything else. Instead I choose to be grateful and appreciative of the blessings in my life. I am happy, Life is good!"

We wish Samantha all the best going forward. She is truly an inspiration to all of us.

The children all had a blast!


