‘How do your feet feel?’

Ephesians 6:1-15

Reality is often a matter of personal perception, as much as objective fact.

Eph. 6:10 to have Eph. 6:15 “feet shod with gospel of peace.”

SHOES OF PEACE:

Shoes = protective binding for the feet.

Feet = are the instruments of movement.
