Bowling Center will be hosting a Jr/Adult Tournament Saturday April 9 ${ }^{\text {th }}, 2022$, at approximately 6:00 PM. Parents, Aunts, Uncles, Grandparents, Coaches, are all invited to participates. So, remember to bring your bowling balls.

## GENERAL INFORMATION: The AZ State USBC will not be responsible for accidents to and from the Tournament site and/or during the tournament. <br> Please bring your confirmation letter.

DRESS CODE: Appropriate attire worn will be neat, clean, and proper fitting. Non-tattered blouses/shirts must have Butterfly Collars or MOCK COLLARS and must have sleeves and be hip length if not tucked in. Nice Pants/Jeans with NO FRAYED HEMLINES, SHORTS, SKORTS, and SKIRTS may be worn if they go past the fingertips 2 inches while standing with arms relaxed by BOTH sides (NO SPORT SHORTS WILL BE ALLOWED), also, no sweatpants, gym pants, nor Leggings will be allowed). Bowlers will not wear hats/caps (unless medically approved). Youth are to be in bowling attire when checking in and stay in the approved attire until finished bowling. Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance, or inappropriate Language/gestures during competition (USBC Rule 301b). Athletes may not smoke or consume alcoholic beverages. The settee and concourse areas will be smoke and alcohol free. This includes E-Cigs. Smoking and alcohol consumption by non-participants will be in designated areas only. No electronic devices will be used by bowlers while bowling in the tournament.

TOURNAMENT EVENTS: Team Event and Singles Event. A bowler is eligible for both events if they qualify through their local tournament.
Team Event: Each area may enter one (1) handicap team per age division and two (2) scratch teams.
Singles Event: Each area may enter a boy and girl in the age handicap division and a boy and girl in the scratch division. Dual participation in an event is not permitted.

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

To be eligible to compete in the Tournament of Champions the following MUST be followed:

1. All entrants must hold a current Youth USBC membership card.
2. All area/city tournaments must be certified by USBC to submit entrants into this tournament.
3. Must bowl in a USBC Youth league within that Association with 15 games or more.
4. Handicap Team entrants MUST BE the actual First Place in the specific age divisions. Handicap First Place Teams that do not meet the specific age divisions are ineligible.
5. Handicap Singles entrants must be the actual First Place All Events winner in each of the specific age divisions, boy and girl. Handicap Singles entrants that do not meet the specific age divisions are ineligible. Scratch Teams can be made up of any gender and age divisions. Scratch Singles should be a First-Place boy and girl regardless of age. It will be the responsibility of the local area/city tournament committee to submit Final Tournament Standings to the Tournament of Champions Director, recognizing the actual First Place Handicap Team and the First Place Handicap All Events Winners according to their specific age divisions as listed below.

DIVISIONS: Handicap and Scratch divisions will be based on the entrant's age as of August 1, 2021.If more than one age group is on a team, the age of the oldest team member shall determine their division. Bantam Division: 8 years and under; Prep Division: 9 years through 11 years; Junior Division: 12 years through 14 years; Major Division: 15 years through 18 years.

This Tournament will follow the Direction of the Arizona Department of Health Services and the CDC regarding any COVID Restrictions

ENTRY FEES: Team Event: $\$ 140.00$ per team: (\$80.00 Lineage\& Expenses; \$60.00 Award/ Scholarships). Singles Event: \$35.00 per entrant: (\$20.00 Lineage\& Expenses; \$15.00 Awards/Scholarships). Entry fees must accompany entries. Awards Fees and Scholarship Fees are returned 100\%.

AVERAGE: Bowlers shall use one of the following methods:
a. Their highest current certified league average, as of February 1, 2022, of 15 games or more.
b. If no average with the 15-game minimum as of February 1, 2022, then a bowler's history of a 15 -game average bowled closest to the date of competition may be used. If a bowler has ONLY a sport league average, then USBC Rule 201C will be used. The average adjustment chart in the USBC Rulebook will determine the "correct" average to be used.
c. Their highest book average from 2020-2021 bowling season.
d. If $a, b$, or $c$ does not apply, Bowler will be given a 220 average for handicap average.

HANDICAP will be ninety (90) percent of the difference between the Team average and 880; ninety (90) percent of the difference between the Singles average and 220.

SUBSTITUTES will be allowed provided they participated in the local city tournament from the area that they are representing and fall within the age for the division they are bowling in.

FORMAT: All entrants in each event will bowl three (3) qualifying games on April 9th, 2022, with the top three (3) in each division of Team and Singles event advancing to bowl in the finals on April $10^{\text {th }}, 2022$. The finalists in each event will bowl three (3) games. Total pins will not carry over from the qualifying games. Total pins plus applicable handicap from the Three (3) games bowled in the finals will determine the winners in each division and each event. If a tie in the finals, there will be $9^{\text {th }} \& 10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off with Handicap for the Handicap division, and a $9^{\text {th }} \& 10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll off with no Handicap for Scratch division.
QUALIFYING SQUAD TIMES will be Saturday, April $9^{\text {th }}$ : Team Squads: 9:00AM, Singles Squad: 2:00PM. If there is a tie for $3^{\text {rd }}$ place all teams/singles in the tie will advance.
TARDY BOWLERS: Tardy bowlers will receive zero (0) for frames missed and will begin a game for score with the frame being bowled.
AWARDS \& SCHOLARSHIPS: Awards will be given to the $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}, \& 3^{\text {rd }}$ Place Winners in each Division of the Team and Singles Event.

Scholarships will be given to the $1^{\text {st }}$ Place Team Members and $1^{\text {st }}$ Place Singles Winners in each Division. Scholarships will be deposited into the Bowler's SMART Account. Top three qualifiers must bowl in Finals to receive awards. If additional funding is available, Scholarships will be presented to finalist on a 1 in 5 ratio of the Entries in each of the divisions. The tournament director is responsible for submitting the scholarships and recipients to the SMART Program, who will administer the scholarships.
AZ STATE USBC will be adding an additional $\$ 15,000$ to the Prize Fund. $\$ 10,000$ for Team Event and $\$ 5,000$ for the Singles Event.

DRESS CODE: Appropriate attire worn will be neat, clean, and proper fitting. Non-tattered blouses/shirts must have Butterfly Collars or MOCK COLLARS and must have sleeves and be hip length if not tucked in. Nice Pants/Jeans with NO FRAYED HEMLINES.
SHORTS, SKORTS, and SKIRTS may be worn if they go past the fingertips 2 inches ON BOTH SIDES, while standing with arms relaxed by their sides (NO SPORT SHORTS WILL BE ALLOWED, no sweatpants, gym pants, or Leggings will be allowed). Bowlers will not wear hats/caps (unless medically approved). Youth are to be in bowling attire when checking in and stay in the approved attire until finished bowling. Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance, or inappropriate Language/gestures during competition (USBC Rule 301b).

- Athletes may not smoke or consume alcoholic beverages.
- The settee and concourse areas will be smoke and alcohol-free zone. Smoking and alcohol consumption by non- participants will be in designated areas only.
- No electronic devices will be used by bowlers while bowling in the tournament. To include cell phones, iPad, Laptops, ETC.
- No one in the bowling/settee except tournament bowlers on this squad, scorekeepers, tournament officials and bowling center staff.
CHECK IN FOR QUALIFYING SQUADS: April $9^{\text {th }}$ : Team Event bowlers will bowl at 9:00 AM and can begin checking in at 8:15 AM. All others are to be checked in by 11:15AM to participate in the Grand March that will begin at 12:00PM noon of all Teams and Singles entrants. Singles Event bowlers will begin bowling at 1:00PM.
FINALS SQUAD TIME will be on Sunday, April 10 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ : Team Squad at 9:00 AM and Singles Squad at 12:00 PM noon. Finalists are to check in one half (1/2) hour prior to squad time. Alternates/substitutes cannot be used in the finals.

ENTRY CLOSING: All entries must be postmarked no later than midnight March 30, 2022.
APPEALS OR PROTESTS: Any appeals or protests regarding scores or eligibility must be made immediately to the Tournament Director. All disputes shall be handled in accordance with the procedures set under USBC Tournament Rules.

1) USBC Junior Gold Event is an optional event for bowlers wishing to attempt to qualify for the Junior Gold Tournament held in Grand Rapids, Michigan on July 15-23, 2022
2) Junior Gold Membership will be available onsite for a fee of $\$ 30.00$ for Youth 12 \& Above; and $\$ 10.00$ for Youth 11 \& Under.
3) Event Fees will be collected prior to the start of the first event based upon the appropriate stated age group entry fees.
4) Entries: Multiple entries are acceptable provide the entrant pays for each entry.
a) Entrants in the Junior Gold Event must bowl all three games. All three games will be used to determine the Junior Gold Event winners.
b) Qualifying is based on scratch scores.
5) Advancement: The Ratio for advancement shall be 1 in 5, or major fraction thereof, into the Junior Gold National Tournament
a) If there is not 5 participants in each division, we will first combine boys and girls for the age group.
b) If a division still does not have enough then we will combine age divisions and separate the Boys/Girls.
c) If still not enough, see rule 5a. Everyone will bowl in the higher age group that signs up, in order to fill any division as needed.
d) There will be no refunds in Junior Gold Tournament.
e) Any leftover funds will be awarded to the Champion of the division in the form of a SMART Scholarship.
