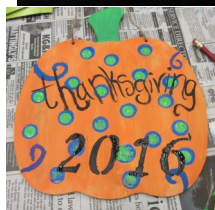
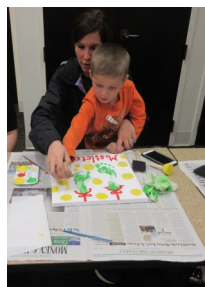
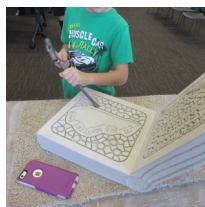
DISNEY DECEMBER
