Information and Guidelines

Eligible applicants for general scholarships:

1. Must be accepted, enrolled, or list which accredited university, college and/or trade school you plan to attend.
2. Must be planning to pursue a degree program in agriculture or an agriculture related program or Law Enforcement.
3. Must be a U.S. Citizen.
4. Applicant or an immediate family member must be a member of the Western States Livestock Rural Enforcement Association (WSLREA, formerly WSLIA).
5. Must have a GPA of 2.75 or greater.
6. Must complete a cover letter.
7. Must complete and submit an application.
8. Must demonstrate a financial need (income question page 2 of application).
9. Must provide transcripts.
10. Awards are up to \$1,000.00 per year. Applicants may reapply annually.

Completed applications must be received by WSLREA by March 1st. Awards will be announced at the end of the annual conference.
