Walking to and Waiting for the Bus

- Find your bus stop ahead of time
- Plan your walking route to the bus stop with parent or guardian
- Arrive five minutes early to the bus stop
- Wait quietly at the stop away from the street
- Stay out of the bus danger zone (twelve feet away from the bus)

Boarding the Bus

- Wait for permission to board the bus.
- Wait for the driver to cross you across the street (pre k through 8th grade); cross in front of the bus, never behind
- Hold on to the rails while boarding
- Be ready to present your bus pass to the driver
- Find a seat, sit down, and buckle up
- Keep the aisle clear

Riding the Bus

- Remain seated at all times facing forward
- Keep head, hands and feet inside the bus at all times
- Talk quietly with friends, no shouting, screaming
- Always listen to the bus driver and follow instructions
- Review the [Bus Rules](#) with your student

Getting Off the Bus

- Wait for permission to exit the bus
- Once off the bus, don't run in front of the bus or in between buses or cars
- Wait for the driver to cross you across the street (pre k through 8th grade); cross in front of the bus, never behind
- Do not attempt to retrieve items left on the bus or items that fell under the bus. Ask the bus driver for help.
