

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**Ordinance No. 2016-17**

**AN ORDINANCE OUT-SOURCING THE ZONING INSPECTOR POSITION,  
ELIMINATING THE IN-HOUSE POSTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Amelia Village requires periodic professional Engineering, Planning and Zoning Services to effectively perform its duties to the citizens of Amelia Village; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of Council to provide cost effective professional Engineering, Planning and Zoning Services to the Village and all of its agencies and departments; and

**WHEREAS**, Village Council has approved a contract with Choice One Engineering Corporation to provide cost -effective professional Engineering, Planning and Zoning Services to the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, there is no longer a need for an in-house Zoning Inspector;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I.** The in-house position of Zoning Inspector shall be eliminated with those services to be provided to the Village under contract with Choice One Engineering Corporation.

**SECTION II.** Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION III.** This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. The reason for such necessity is the immediate need to continue providing cost effective and professional engineering, planning and zoning services to the Village and its residents. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
