

Ordinance No 506.

An Ordinance Regulating and
Prohibiting the sale and use of ex-
plosives in the city of Topeka, Kansas,
and for the protection of persons and
property in said city, and fixing penalties for
violations of this ordinance.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and
Councilmen of the city of Topeka, Kansas,

Section 1. It shall be unlawful
for any person or persons, in the city of
Topeka, Kansas, to expose for sale,
offer for sale, or sell, any dynamite
exp. blank cartridges, gun powder,
torpedoes, sky rockets, or other gun
works or explosives.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful
for any person or persons, to rise, fire
off, explode, or cause to be ex-
ploded, in the city of Topeka, Kansas,
any of the gun works or explosives
mentioned in Section 1 of this ordinance.

in 3. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ^{ordinance} shall, upon conviction be fined in a sum not exceeding \$ 5.00. for each offense, and may shall pay the costs of prosecution, and may be confined in the city prison until such fine and costs are paid.

Section 4. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to prohibit the sale ~~or~~ use, of black powder, dynamite, or other explosive for industrial purposes, nor prohibited by other ordinances, or the sale and use of ^{loaded} cartridges and other ammunition for fire arms; and provided further that the mayor and council may grant permission to any responsible person, persons, or committee, for patriotic displays or fire works on the Fourth of July, or such other occasions as they may deem proper, under proper directions as to the protection,

Secton 5 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the council & and publication in the official city paper.
