January's Meeting Minutes:

Seneschal's Report: The Honorable Lady Aesa reported that Boar's Head was really good, we had the biggest populace space that was there. New Year's Moot is coming up.

Chatelaine Report: Lady Wynne has reported that the November demo was cancelled due to the bad weather. The next building for kids demo is quickly approaching. Bring water and snacks for that day! It was reported that we have 84 new contacts, and that 7 are active on Social Media but that they are not yet attending events. A contact sheet has been prepared on the baronial business cards to keep a tab on everyone that shows interest. The brochures have been revamped to be more accessible.

Windy Tuesday's are planned up to March , zoom calls are available every Tuesday with 3- 6 people in attendance, with some from as far away as Canada!

Exchequer Report: Hilde Steward reported that we just got the Kingdom's exchequer's signature and that we are still working on getting everyone else's. There was a brief concern that someone had access to the account but that there was no evidence anything was touched. The exchequer will now get an email if anyone accesses the account. Everyone will also have their own username/password so when there is a changeover, everyone will have new information and it will be more secure. The Annual has been provided and a motion was passed to approve budget.
