Minutes of meeting held April 21, 1980 were read and approved as read.

Bretzke stated that Carl Carpenter recommended that the District advertise for a pump for each of the Schumaker Wells, but did not feel that a booster pump would be necessary for either well. Bretzke said that the agreement with Spanish Valley Water & Sewer Improvement District states that the Conservancy District will sell water to SVW&SID on a basis of how much they use.
