Please call 419-946-4191 to schedule an appointment (REQUIRED)
to have your taxes prepared and e-filed.

Please bring a copy of your last year's return along with a picture ID for the taxpayer(s) on the return.

Social Security cards or ITIN documentation for all.

Income documents – Forms W2, SSA, 1099, 1099R, 1099G, other 1099 forms, or self-employment income along with any other income documents you may have.

Brokerage statements – sale of stocks or bonds.

Healthcare – 1095 A, B, or C: marketplace exemption letters.

Bank check for direct deposit/debit refund/balance due.

Receipts for all deductions to itemize.

Records of federal and state taxes paid.

Educational expenses – Form 1098-T and expense receipts.
