Lewis W. Tibbits, Sr., 86, long time Pinnebog Area farmer, died Friday morning, April 26, at the Tuscola County Medical Care Facility, Caro.

He was born March 29, 1910 in Chandler Twp. at the home of his parents, the late Lewis and Bebbie (Maynard) Tibbits.
