**1. Selectmen Meeting was called to order approximately at 6:32 PM by Dwight Warren.**

**2. Review/ Approve meeting minutes**

The truck is two months behind it's scheduled delivery date, and the Town has been making payments on the truck.
- July 16<sup>th</sup> Special Town Meeting: Selectmen reviewed and voted 3-0 to sign the special town meeting warrant for July 16<sup>th</sup> special town meeting.
- Old Business
  - Review Camera quotes - Selectmen read and reviewed the camera quotes. Selectmen discussed and decided to get more quotes regarding a hard-wired security camera system. The current cameras are having connectivity issues and are not reliable.
  - Sand Pond Complaints – Town office received a complaint regarding naked children on the beach. The incident diffused shortly after the complaint. Russ was made aware of the situation.
