

The Acts of a Street Preacher

Introduction

The former treatise hath the Bible made, O lovers of God, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen to go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. Those same apostles knew for certain, exactly what the Lord intended for them to do, and “went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following.” (Luke 1:1/ Mark 16:15 & 20).

And as the Acts of Apostles records the beginning of that obedient endeavor of the saints of God, who from the beginning of the church, did manifest God’s word through preaching (Titus 1:3) while “earnestly contending for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints” (Jude 3); so too shall the Acts of the Street Preachers endeavor with God’s help to record the final chapters of the conflict, wherein this world and the God called street preachers are on a collision course of prophetic proportions (Revelation 11:8-10). But that fight for the faith, was never intended to be this Fundamentalists circus of showmanship found throughout the refined pulpits of modern day Christianity, where the divine ministers are clergy instead of soldiers, effeminate love-sick sodomites and whoremongers instead of “holy men of God” (2 Peter 1:21), and spineless gospel entertainers who for hire confine the word of God behind four walls instead of strong Preachers with the courage to take the word of God into the highways and streets and lanes of the cities, and preach the gospel to every creature, regardless of the costs. The former has nothing whereof they may boast in Christ (2 Corinthians 11:16-19) beyond a fool’s glory in the flesh. The latter have their record on high, and the testimony of a clear conscience that “it is done as thou hast commanded” (Luke 14:21). This is a recollection of those fanatical men that make up the latter. They are the street preachers. A special breed of men, born of God and called to do what others fear to imagine. They are on a collision course with the world that will no doubt end with death in the streets where they preach (Revelation 11:7,8). With God’s help, this is their story.
