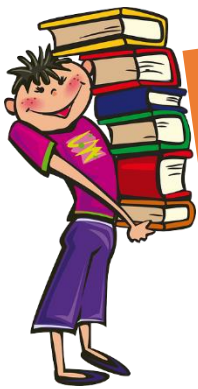
Garnett Public Library Book Discussion

___ Participating as a **cookie baker & tidbit maker** (This is the committee we call on when we are having an event that requires cookies or other goodies)

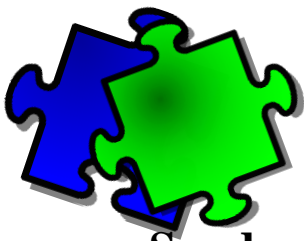
___ **Any Committee needing help.**

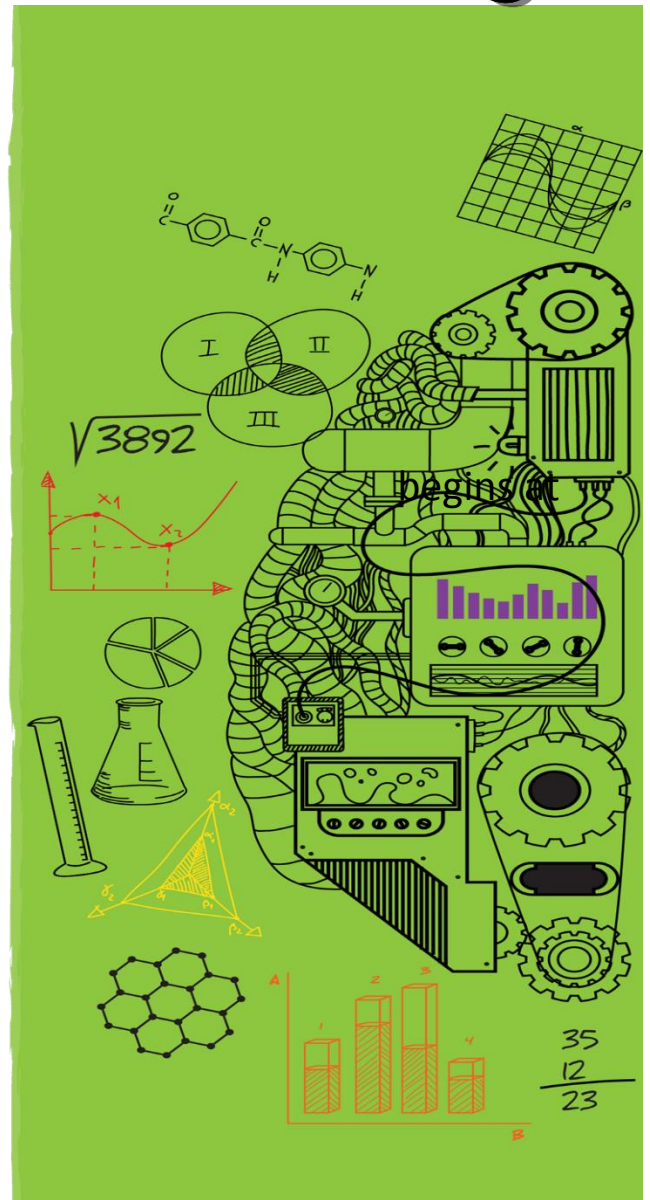
