



Fall School Days: Home and Harvest Program

Join the History Museum at the Castle for a fun and educational field trip! Fall School Days: Home and Harvest teaches students about pioneer life in Wisconsin from 1800 to 1860. Visiting students experience 20 demonstrations and hands-on activities, including threshing, candle dipping, butter making, quill writing, corn shelling, and 19th century games.

Details:

Grade levels: 2nd-5th

Rates: \$4.50/student. Adults are free. One adult per 10 students is required, but you may bring more.

Location: Plamann Park, 1375 E Broadway Drive, Appleton, WI 54913. In the weeks before the program, you will receive a map showing the exact location within the park where the program will be held.

We typically have schools on a waiting list for the program. If the event is cancelled due to weather, your school may choose one of the following options:

- A class visit to the History Museum at the Castle
- A School Days Online program. This is a classroom-style presentation with some interactive activities. The subject matter covers that in Fall and Spring School Days, including the Fur Trade and Home & Harvest. Available times for School Days Online will be:

 - Thursday, October 12 at 1:00 PM
- One complimentary child admission with a paying adult visit to the History Museum at the Castle for each of your students
