NOTICE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

By affixing his or her signature below, Renter hereby acknowledges that boats and water crafts of any sort are inherently dangerous and by renting a boat, Renter understands that he or she and Renter's guests and family may be seriously injured or killed due to drowning or other injury. Renter hereby waves any and all claims of any sort, including claims for property damage, death, personal injury, pain, suffering, mental anguish, medical bills and treatment that may be incurred by Renter, his or her family and guests, and explicitly agrees to indemnify and hold Anchorage Marine, Inc. or Anchorage Boat Dock, its successors, and assigns HARMLESS from and against any and all liabilities, losses, costs, damages, expenses, including attorney's fees, claims, suits, and judgements in connection with the injury or death of any person(s), loss or damage to any property, including property of the Renter, arising out of or related to the Equipment or conduct of Anchorage Marine, Inc. and its employees regardless of whether such injury, death, loss or damage results in whole or part from any negligence of, tort liability of or breach of any duty owed under contract or statute by Anchorage Marine, Inc. its employees, its agents, or otherwise.

ABILITY TO OPERATE:

Renter warrants that he/she is QUALIFIED and COMPETENT to operate the Equipment rented, including any and all watercraft and agrees to operate same in specified area in a careful and prudent manner at all times and to obey all rules governing use of said Equipment, including provisions of the Georgia Boat Safety Act. Renters agree not to allow equipment to be unattended. Renter acknowledges that he or she understands the aforementioned Act and the rules of safety for operating watercraft, including rules of the road and proper use of safety equipment. Renter acknowledges that he or she has been shown how to operate the watercraft rented and has had an opportunity to ask questions about its operation.

**RENTER AGREES TO AND ACKNOWLEDGES THE FOLLOWING RULES
RELATED TO THE RENTAL:**

1. Renter is responsible for refilling the fuel (at Anchorage Boat Dock) in any watercraft used during your rental before returning it to the docking area where you boarded. A fuel deposit is required in the form of a credit card. **Failure to fill vessel with gas will result in full load of fuel charged to your credit card. Returning late will result in an additional hourly fee for any part of an hour.**
2. No refunds for weather. No refunds for returning early.

3. Renter is responsible for keeping the boat reasonably clean. Please do not throw trash away at the gas dock. Instead use the green dumpster located at the rental shop.
4. Renter is responsible for all damage to the vessel and or any other item or items you come in contact with while vessel is rented. A \$90.00 per hour labor rate will be charged for repairs. All items will be ordered through our suppliers to make necessary repairs. You are responsible for lost revenue during repairs. If you did something to the boat (i.e run it out of gas, run battery dead,...etc.) and someone has to go out and get you a \$75.00 service fee will be added to your bill. If for any reason we feel you are abusing the watercraft or rental items, you will forfeit the rest of your rental fee and the watercraft will be confiscated on the spot. Jet Skis: (rolling it over, sucking anything into the pump,...etc.) is your financial responsibility to repair. **Any life jackets, tubes, ropes, skis, wake boards.....etc, must be turned in and accounted for once your rental is complete. Renter will be charged a replacement fee for any missing items provided by Anchorage Marine, Inc.**
5. **Pets or grilling are not allowed on any boat. A \$75.00 cleaning fee will be added to your bill if caught with an animal on any boat without permission.**
6. You and your party must adhere to and obey all Georgia boating laws and regulations. The 100' rule is in effect on all Georgia Lakes.
7. **Only persons whose signatures are on this Agreement are allowed to operate boat.** Renter, as well as any person named below as a potential operator of the boat, have VIEWED and AGREE that they UNDERSTAND the boater's safety video program approved by the Georgia DNR. Renter understands and acknowledges that only Renter and the persons named below as potential operators of the boat are the only persons allowed to operate the boat. No other person is allowed to operate the boat under any circumstances! If renter allows any person to operate the boat who is not authorized by this Agreement to operate the boat, Anchorage Marine, Inc. reserves the right to seize the boat, take control of the boat, and take the boat immediately into its possession. If Renter allows any person other than those listed below to operate the boat, Renter forfeits any deposits or payments made and will be charged for the remainder of the Agreement.

VENUE AND JURISDICITON:

This agreement will be governed by the Laws of The State of Georgia and venue and jurisdiction for any dispute hereunder will be in the Superior Court of Rabun County, Georgia.
