The program begins with coffee and registration at 8:00 a.m. at The Collider, on the 4th floor of the Wells Fargo Building overlooking Pritchard Park in downtown Asheville

Entrance into the building at this time of day (because it is a bank building) is via the glass door facing Patton Avenue, a few steps around the corner from the ATM and directly across from the former S&W building. (The revolving door that is the main bank entrance opens at 9am.) Take the elevator to the 4th floor. You can also enter through the Wells Fargo parking garage on College St. and take the elevator to the 4th floor. *****Please do not park in the parking garage; it is reserved strictly for bank customers.***

The program is scheduled to start in The Collider Theater promptly at 8:45 a.m. with opening remarks. Presentations begin at 9 a.m. and end with closing remarks at 4:00 p.m. Lunch will be on your own at many available venues within an easy walk. The day will conclude with an add-on discussion and networking opportunity at a nearby venue. r.
