

Early Intervention serves children under 3 with developmental delays. We give families tools to support their child's development and participation in family life.

Family Programs

The Family Support Program provides resources to families who have a member with IDD living in the home. Families can also get respite through the TAMBO respite program. The Children's Medicaid Waivers provide specialized supports to eligible kids and their families.
