
- Crating will be available in the building with 6 foot distances. Be courteous to leave when your class is finished and remove your crate so there is ample room for the next scheduled exhibitors.
- Cones will be used for figure 8 posts.
- Jump heights will be in order small to tall.
- We will be following AKC Obedience/Rally guidelines and suggestions for best practices for the well-being of the dog sport participants dated May 12, 2020 and any subsequent updates.
- Please bring your own chair. There will be marks on the floor for you to place your chair ensuring 6 ft between chairs. Bring your chair in and set up without your dog.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From the East or West: I-94 exit 275 (Sullivan/Ixonia) Cty F. Go north on Cty F to Cty P (approximately 4.5 miles) or Elmwood Avenue. Turn west (left) approximately 1/2 mile to Cedar Drive. Right on Cedar Drive to building at end of road on left.

From the North or South: Hwy 16 west or east to Ixonia. This is approximately 5 miles west of Oconomowoc or 8 miles east of Watertown. Turn left on Cty F approximately 3/4 miles to Cty P (Elmwood Avenue). Just past the railroad tracks. Turn right on Cty P approximately 1/2 mile to Cedar Drive. Right on Cedar Drive to building at end of road on left.

Dogs competing in Rally Novice A, Advanced A, or Excellent A classes may not have attained an AKC Rally Novice A or obedience CD, CDX, or UD. Dogs must be handled by owner or member of the owner's household or immediate family.

Move ups will be permitted.

Covid-19 guidelines will be in place. Subject to change depending the State, Local and National regulations at time of trial.

- If you are feeling sick, have a fever, cough or are sneezing before leaving for the trial, please stay home. If you have recently been in the presence of someone who has either tested positive for Covid-19 or has the symptoms mentioned above stay home. You can text the trial secretary if you are unable to attend. (Text 414-507-0000)
- There will be enterance and exit doors marked.
- No spectators will be allowed in the building.
- Check-in will be as you arrive at the building at a common location. You will receive a check-in time with instructions after entries close.
- Masks will be required at all times in the building when you are not able to maintain social distancing, when checking in, and when approaching the stewards table.
- Masks are required at the judge's discretion for exhibiting your dog in the ring.
- Should the trial be cancelled due to COVID regulations, entry fees will be returned to the exhibitor.
- Ribbons will be self-serve at ringside after the awards for the class,
