

Minutes from March 4, 2019 Meeting

The Club met at Stono Ferry on March 4, 2019 at 6pm. Carol opened the meeting with the pledge and Patty gave the invocation. A delicious meal of Quiche Lorraine, salad, rolls, and Brownie Sunday was enjoyed by all. Following the meal the speaker Nyre Taylor Director of Operations told us about the Halos program. H-helping A- and L- lending O-outreach S-support. This program provides Kindship care with support groups for behavior issues, education, etc. They also help foster parents with necessary items such as diapers, school uniforms, etc. They send these children to camp for the summer through a Charleston County Parks programs. Last year they provided 1200 children with book bags for school and 2 school uniforms. At Christmas they provided 2,800 children with gifts. HALOS is the only organization in SC that offers kindship support. Following Ms. Taylors talk the club voted to donate \$325.00 to send one child to camp for the entire summer. Members also made cash donations and donated items such as baby wipes, diapers, etc.

Steve reported on membership dues with several members who have not renewed their membership or paid their dues. This will be looked into before the next meeting. Officers for 2019-2020 have been elected with the exception of Secretary. The club is looking to fill that position before the September meeting.

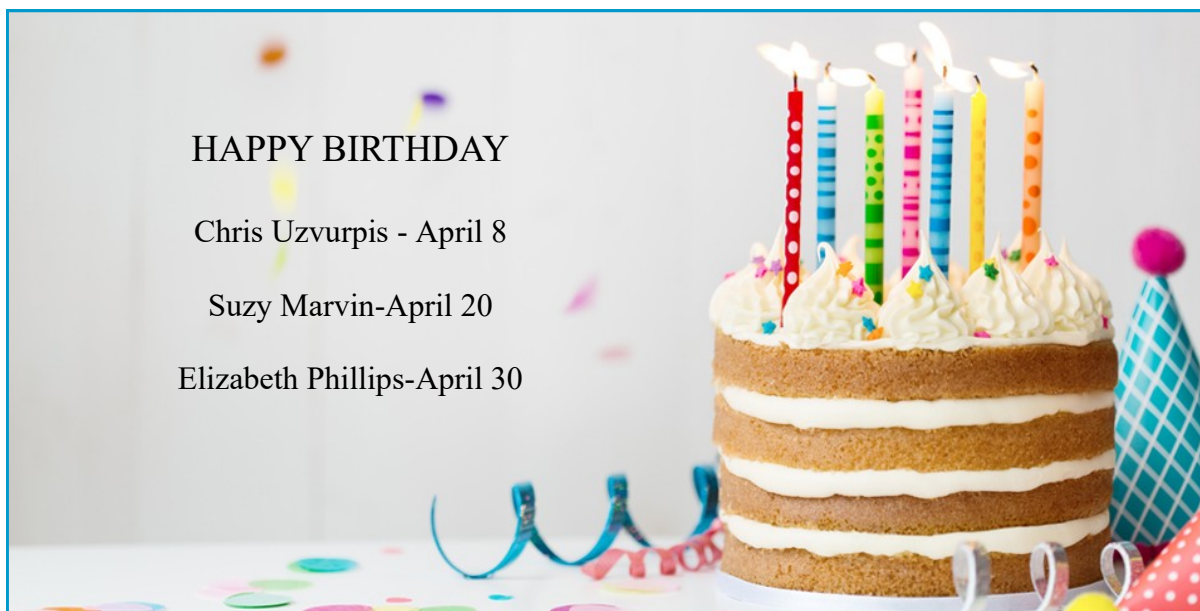
