

The Bear Creek Ski Patrol EMT Bridge Course

The Bear Creek Ski Patrol is again hosting the EMT Bridge course for all those who are interested. This hybrid course is designed to cover the necessary material required for the EMT certification and further develop a patroller's skills through different scenarios and ambulance observations.

Tuition:

- Cost: \$600/Patrollers
- Tuition includes textbook, online access, test prep, and a class t-shirt.

Course Details:

- Course will be held from May to September.
- Patrollers will schedule their written exam upon successful course with the National Registry of EMTs. **The costs associated with the written exam is not included in the course's tuition.**
- Patrollers will complete 10 patient contacts while doing observations on the ambulance.
- Patrollers will participate in a vehicle extrication day and along with other opportunities associated with the course.

Course Requirements:

- At least 2-3 years of active duty with their patrol
- Are at least 16 years of age
- Have an active CPR card approved by the Pa DOH for healthcare providers
- Have completed NIMS 100 – additional NIMS courses will be required for the course.
- A Letter of Recommendation from their Patrol Director.

All patrollers are eligible for this course, the state is no longer requiring patrollers to have their EMR certifications.
