READING AND APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MINUTE

APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Katy Kleymeyer presented the Monthly Financial Report showing the spending for July 1, 2021- June 30 2022.

REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF ANNUAL BUDGET

Katy presented a Budget Report for 2022 – 2023. Income of \$10,375.00 from 83 homes at \$125.00 each. Balance in account as of June 30, 2022, is \$9,590.53. Income plus the balance gives total assets \$19,965.53. Katy noted that our actual bank balance as of July 14, 2022 was \$15,118.54. Katy also pointed out the cost of the post office box rental fee had gone up since the report. Budget Report shows \$150 new fee is \$166.00 Motion to approve by Bill Howlett seconded by Ricky Drawbaugh.

Katy also commented, when a homeowner does not pay their dues it can result in a lien on the property with the homeowner being responsible to reimburse the association all fees for filing the lien and removing it. An estimate of \$200, the homeowner could owe the association.

Bill Howlett had questions about the \$2,000 legal fee on the 2022-2023 budget. This being a retainer fee to Mr. Greenberg, attorney, for meeting with the board and giving instruction and advice. Part of it will be refunded. Jim and Katy will be contacting Mr. Greenberg to get refund from the original retainer.
