# A Word to the Fore: Suddenly Last Summer

Seems like every issue, I hold back a little something to write about next time--and then things I never imagined happen in the meantime.

When wrapping up last issue, I had no idea an opportunity to attend the Missouri Auction School online was about to come along. I've long been fascinated with auctioneering, wrote an article on the psychology of auctions for "Hoof Beats" magazine in 1997, and had a great time serving as auctioneer for the 1995-98 NAMHSA and 1998 West Coast Model Horse Jamboree benefit auctions before moving to Japan. Now that I'm back, the time seems right to dust off that dream--and now I'm a Missouri Auction School graduate, preparing to take the exam for my Texas license!

Something else unforeseen was a related course of study in appraising personal property. It was really intriguing, so I pursued that too, and earned my certification from the Certified Appraisers Guild of America.

All of this was able to happen without leaving our room, what with the COVID-19 pandemic storming along with no end in sight. Just over six months ago, the day the Spring 2020 Re-View came out, there were 1,407,123 confirmed cases worldwide with 80,759 deaths, including the U.S.'s 383,256 confirmed cases and 12,021 deaths. As of today, there are 37,728,386 confirmed cases worldwide with 1,078,629 deaths, including the U.S.'s 7,803,259 confirmed cases and 214,061 deaths.

Due to the pandemic, BreyerFest, Breyer's annual gathering that draws upwards of 30,000 model horse hobbyists to the Kentucky Horse Park, was changed to a virtual event this year. Participating from our room, we cheered when Liz Isham Cory mentioned vintage customs in her overview presentation on the hobby, and were glued to the screen as the BreyerFest Virtual Open photo show was judged in real time online, with some vintage customs even emerging with hard-earned placings! You'll find photos of those standouts, along with the rest of our coverage of some other notable summer shows, starting on page 6.

At right is another vintage custom representing for the cause: MN Expensive Property, customized by Michelle Belisle Locke in 2000, was recently voted the Model Equine Photo Showers Association's 2020 Horse Of The Year in its Customized division! Nicknamed "Expo," this engaging guy also nabbed that huge MEPSA honor in 2017. Expo, his MEPSA awards, and his several NAMHSA North American National Championship plaques will eventually be featured in the VCMEC Museum. Thanks so much to Marie J. Phillips for proxy-showing him for me in MEPSA!

Speaking of showing, this issue of the Re-View is actually the very first with no VCMEC show results. Normally, the results of VCMEC Live would be in this issue. Cheryl Ridge has also been tremendously helpful on the monster project that is the Vintage CM Census 2020; thank you so much, Cheryl! For sanity's sake--ours as well as yours!--we've extended the deadline for submissions to December 31. Summer is peak model horse show season--but none before have been quite like this!



But with the COVID pandemic raging, NAMHSA cancelled the NAN, BreyerFest became a worldwide virtual happening on schedule in July, and Equilocity was held online in August.



# Underlying Genius, Part 1: The Breyer Molds of Chris Hess

A vintage custom model horse is a factory mass-produced model that was altered by a non-factory artist in the year 2000 or earlier. Most began as Breyer plastic models--and no one created more molds for Breyer than the late Christian Hess.

Between sculpting the Western Horse in 1950 and Secretariat in 1987, Hess created over 100 equine models for Breyer, in addition to overseeing the company's mold tooling and decoration. Here's a look at each of the molds he sculpted for Breyer, pictured in factory paint (a state called "OF" in the hobby, for "original finish"), to see what's beneath the physical remaking, repainting, and hair of many vintage customs.





# Underlying Genius, Part 2: The Breyer Molds of Maureen Love

A vintage custom model horse is a factory mass-produced model that was altered by a non-factory artist in the year 2000 or earlier. Most began as Breyer plastic models--with some of those Breyers being plastic versions of molds sculpted by the late Maureen Love (Calvert) for ceramic figurine producer Hagen- Renaker, who leased these molds to Breyer starting in the mid-1970s.

Here's a look at Breyer's plastic versions of molds that Love sculpted for Hagen-Renaker, each pictured in factory paint (a state called "OF" in the hobby, for "original finish"), to see what's beneath the physical remaking, repainting, and hair of many vintage customs.


