### **Young Investigator's Award Competition**

If you are a resident or fellow in a training program, consider applying for our Young Investigator Award Competition.

The purpose of this competition is to encourage young physicians, research fellows and trainees to engage in high quality research, which forms the basis for future achievement in the pathophysiology of disease, diagnosis, and treatment. The Scientific Committee will judge entries on originality, innovativeness, scientific merit, presentation, and relevance. The finalist will deliver a 15-minute oral presentation. The International College of Angiology reserves the right to publish the prize-winning manuscript in the International Journal of Angiology. The winner(s) will be given a cash award in the amount of USD \$1000 and one-year Associate Membership in the International College of Angiology. There are three (3) awards – medical, surgical, and basic research. The deadline for submission of an abstract for this award is **June 15, 2024**. Abstracts will be submitted online as noted above. Previous recipients of a Young Investigator Award will be ineligible. - Applicant's academic rank cannot be higher than Associate Professor or Lecturer and must not have held this position for more than 3 years.
- The scientific work is mainly the result of the applicant's effort.
- Materials must be original, unpublished, and not previously presented.
- Only one (1) submission per author will be considered. The candidate must be the sole or first author and must be present at the Award Ceremony to receive the award.
- The submission must be accompanied by certification from the candidate's Head of the Division that the candidate executed the work, that the candidate's academic rank is not higher than Associate Professor or Lecturer, and length of time in this position.
- Any finalist who cannot personally present their work will be ineligible for the award.
