QB Nico Iamaleava led UCLA to a shocking 42-37 upset of No. 7 Penn State last Saturday. The Bruins were 24.5-point underdogs, more than 10/1 on the moneyline and became the first 0-4 team or worse in 40 years to beat a AP Top 10 team.

Virginia (+6.5) upset Louisville 30-27 in overtime. However, Louisville had a 383-237 yard edge. Virginia got a 61-yard fumble return TD and a 47-yard interception return TD.

SMU (-18) beat Syracuse 31-18. However, Syracuse had a 389-370 yard edge. The Orange were -2 in turnovers. They were also stopped on downs at the SMU 1-yard line and also the SMU 10.

UNLV (-4.5) beat Wyoming 31-17. Wyoming had a 356-255 yard edge. The Cowboys were -2 in turnovers. UNLV got a pair of blocked punts and returned both for touchdowns.

Bad Beats

TCU (-13.5) beat Colorado 35-21. The Buffaloes were -4 in turnovers. Colorado led 14-0. The game was tied at 21-21 in the middle of the fourth quarter. TCU got a 21-yard TD pass on 4th & 6 with just :19 left for the cover.

USF (-28) beat Charlotte 54-26. After recovering an onside kick, USF decided to still run their offense and scored a TD with :43 left to get a push vs the closing line. The line was less than -28 for most of the week.

Alabama (-12.5) beat Vanderbilt 30-14. After taking over on downs, Alabama decided to run their offense in the closing minute. On 4th & 2, Alabama got a 20-yard TD run with :17 left.

-Michigan WR Fredrick Moore plans to enter the transfer portal.

-Iowa QB Mark Gronowski partook in practice on Tuesday.

-Oregon State has fired special teams coordinator Jamie Christian

-BYU LB Jack Kelly (shoulder) is questionable this week.

-TCU OL Ryan Hughes (leg) is out for the season.

-Arizona TE Keyan Burnett will redshirt the remainder of the 2025 season.

-Virginia Tech RB Terion Stewart (shoulder) is questionable this week.

Wednesday, October 8th

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Missouri State 25 MIDDLE TENNESSEE 24. One factor handicap. Will Missouri State starting QB Jacob Clark play or not. He's 50/50 after getting injured in the last game. True Frosh Deuce Bailey would be making his first start if Clark can't go. We bet Middle and UNDER.
Liberty 24 UTEP 23. Liberty is just 4-14 ATS in their last 18 games dating back to the Fiesta Bowl a couple of years ago. They were the overwhelming preseason CUSA favorites and are fighting for their bowl lives already. UTEP has the better ypp margin (+0.2 vs -0.5).

Thursday, October 9th

Louisiana Tech 25 KENNESAW STATE 19. Louisiana Tech is 5-0 ATS covering their games by an average of 15.3 ppg. Kennesaw State is playing their 4th straight home game and won the previous three. We bet Kennesaw despite LT's ATS record and so far the market agrees.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN 31 Southern Miss 30. The market continues to love this Southern Miss team. They've actually been outgained on the season despite a 3-2 record. Georgia Southern's stats are bad (-1.6 in ypp margin) but they've played a much tougher schedule than Southern Miss (No. 52 vs No. 118). We bet Georgia Southern at +3.5.

Jacksonville State 31 SAM HOUSTON STATE 24. Sam Houston is 0-5 SU and 0-5 ATS failing to cover their games by 13.8 points per game. They were favored at New Mexico State last week and lost 37-10. Jacksonville State is better in the stats (-0.1 ypp margin vs -2.1) but Sam Houston has played the tougher schedule (No. 32 vs No. 109).

TULANE 30 East Carolina 23. ECU has been the better team in the stats (+1.1 vs -0.2 in ypp margin) but Tulane has played the tougher schedule (No. 31 vs No. 85). Both teams are coming off a bye. Pass.

Friday, October 10th

South Florida 33 NORTH TEXAS 31. Huge game in the American with both teams still having playoff aspirations. NT has been the better team in ypp margin (+1.8 vs +1.4) but USF has played a much more difficult schedule (No. 39 vs No. 115). NT does have a pair of OT wins so they've been a bit fortunate. Both teams do run a lot of tempo as USF ranks No. 3 in plays per minute while North Texas is No. 18. That's why you have such a high total. We like USF here.

Fresno State 25 COLORADO STATE 20. Fresno State has quietly won 5 straight games since the Week Zero loss at Kansas. The competition hasn't been the stiffest but they are +0.9 in ypp. Colorado State is a mess right now. The Rams are 1-4 and their head coach is starting to feel some heat. We didn't bet this game.

WASHINGTON 34 Rutgers 25. Rutgers comes in off a bye after suffering a couple of 4Q losses to Iowa and Minnesota. We know they're traveling across the country but we don't mind the spot for them here catching Washington off three straight emotional games (rivalry, Ohio State, 20-point comeback).

Saturday, October 11th

KENT STATE 25 Massachusetts 24. The two worst teams in the FBS face off here. UMass ranks No. 134 in ypp margin at -2.2 while Kent State ranks No. 136 at -2.7. Kent has played the much tougher schedule (No. 5 vs No. 79). Tough making Kent a favorite when they are 1-25 straight up in their last 26 games.

Navy 31 TEMPLE 24. Navy comes in off the dramatic 34-31 win over Air Force. WR Heidenreich had a school-record 243 yards receiving. Navy is 5-0 and is one of several AAC teams looking for that playoff spot. Temple has been much better than expected this year and the Owls are coming off an upset of UTSA. We like them here anything above a TD as Navy has struggled in the favorite role.

CINCINNATI 32 Central Florida 22. UCF might be without QB Tayven Jackson here. Cam Fancher is a downgrade and UCF scored ZERO points in the second half last week without Jackson. Cincinnati has been impressive with a 4-1 SU and 4-1 ATS mark. They're off the win over Iowa State which they led 31-7 but had to hang on. We haven't bet side or total.

FLORIDA ATLANTIC 36 Uab 30. UAB has the better ypp margin (+0.0 vs -0.3) and both have played similar strength of schedules. FAU comes in off the upset of Rice. The Owls run the 2nd fastest tempo in the country despite their ranking 91st in ypp. Pass.

ARMY 34 Charlotte 16. Charlotte is banged up and got out-gained 631-279 last week at USF. Army is a tough luck 2-3 team with a pair of OT losses to unbeaten teams. Not ideal laying a huge number with them though. We lean OVER at current.

JAMES MADISON 33 UL-Lafayette 16. James Madison was 4-0 ATS but had an uninspiring 14-7 non-cover win at Georgia State last week. ULL comes in off a bye after a dramatic OT comeback win over Marshall. We lean OVER.

Old Dominion 35 MARSHALL 21. Right now we think ODU is the best team in the Sun Belt and keep an eye on them for the G5 playoffs too. They're only loss is by 13 to Top 10 Indiana and they hammered Virginia Tech. Marshall is off a bye. The Herd have a pair of tough losses this year. QB Del Rio-Wilson is No. 1 in passer rating completing 78.5% of his passes with a 9-0 ratio.

Appalachian State 28 GEORGIA STATE 25. App State had a misleading win over Oregon State last week (see page 1). Meanwhile, Georgia State is off their best performance of the season in a near upset of James Madison. Georgia State has played the much tougher schedule (No. 11 vs No. 128).

PENN STATE 34 Northwestern 13. Penn State is coming off one of their worst losses in school history. The Nittany Lions favored by 24.5 points lost to a 0-4 UCLA team that hadn't held a lead at any point this season coming into the game. Penn State is now 0-5 ATS on the year failing to cover by 11.3 points per game. They would need to win out to make the playoffs (unlikely). What frame of mind are they in here?

Clemson 34 BOSTON COLLEGE 20. Clemson comes in off their best performance of the season as the Tigers crushed North Carolina. Meanwhile, Boston College comes in off their worst performance of the season as they lost 48-7 to a short-handed Pitt team starting a true freshman at QB. That's 4 straight losses for them. Have they let go of the rope? We'll know early on.

FLORIDA STATE 35 Pittsburgh 25. FSU was dominated for the first three quarters vs Miami last week. However, give them credit for making the final respectable as they outscored the Canes 19-0 down the stretch. They're taking on a Pitt team that is off their best performance of the season. True frosh QB Mason Heintschel will be making his first road start. We lean OVER at current.

GEORGIA TECH 34 Virginia Tech 19. Georgia Tech comes in off a much-needed bye after surviving a trip to Wake Forest. Meanwhile, VT is coming off an upset loss to Wake Forest and the Hokies could be without top RB Stewart here. We didn't bet side or total.

Iowa 20 WISCONSIN 16. Iowa comes in off a bye and it looks like QB Mark Gronowski will be able to go here. Wisconsin has started three different QB's this season already and the Badgers will likely be underdogs in every remaining game on their schedule. Lowest total of the season so far. We bet Iowa.

MICHIGAN STATE 32 UCLA 24. UCLA comes in off the biggest upset of the CFB season so far. The Bruins upset No. 7 Penn State 42-37 as 24.5-point underdogs. The stars were new-OC Jerry Neuheisel and QB Nico Iamaleava. They're facing a Michigan State team that was better than the final vs Nebraska last week. We bet Michigan State and OVER early in the week and so far market agrees.

UL-Monroe 24 COASTAL CAROLINA 22. Coastal is a mess. They are No. 130 in ypp margin, No. 132 in ypg margin and No. 131 in scoring margin. If 3-2 ULM has legit bowl aspirations (only been to one in their history), they need to take care of business here.

Miami, Ohio 28 AKRON 19. Miami is starting to get some momentum off back-to-back wins. Akron got QB Finley back last week and upset CMU. They're a completely different team with him in the lineup and we lean with them getting the hook.

Toledo 29 BOWLING GREEN 20. The I-75 rivalry sees both teams coming off a bye. Toledo has the much better stats (+2.7 ypp margin vs -1.0) but Bowling Green has played the much tougher schedule (No. 40 vs No. 132). Toledo head coach Jason Candle has lost outright 16 times as a favorite since 2021 including 11 laying a TD or more. We like the home dog here especially above 10.

EASTERN MICHIGAN 23 Northern Illinois 22. Eastern Michigan suffered a tough OT loss to Buffalo last week as they held a lead in the final seconds. NIU has one of the worst units in the country. Their offense ranks No. 135 in ypp, ypg and scoring. The only offense worse is Massachusetts. We lean EMU getting the point.

TEXAS TECH 35 Kansas 22. Texas Tech is not only 5-0 straight up but they are 5-0 ATS covering their games by an average of 10.2 points per game. The Red Raiders rank No. 2 in the country in ypp margin, ypg margin and scoring margin. Kansas comes in off the fortunate win over UCF where they stopped the Knights on the goal line late. We lean Kansas getting the hook.

WESTERN MICHIGAN 27 Ball State 17. Western Michigan is 5-1 ATS covering their games by an average of 8.1 ppg. Ball State comes in off a huge upset win over Ohio as they rallied from a 14-point deficit. We lean with WMU as long as it's under 10.

Alabama 29 MISSOURI 26. There's a lot to this handicap. First, Missouri is the better team in the stats with a +2.8 ypp margin. They're also the better running team (No. 3 vs No. 105). However, Alabama has played the much more difficult schedule (No. 4 vs No. 150). The Tigers are off a bye and are playing their 6th straight game at home. Alabama is off a pair of full 60-minute efforts vs Georgia and Vanderbilt. We lean OVER at current.

OLE MISS 45 Washington State 14. Both teams come in off a bye. Ole Miss is +1.9 in ypp margin while playing the No. 22 schedule. Washington State is -0.6 in ypp margin while playing the No. 64 schedule. Ole Miss has Georgia and Oklahoma on deck. Not sure how much they'll want margin here.

Iowa State 28 COLORADO 23. Iowa State is really banged up. They don't have a scholarship kicker and lost both starting CB's for the season. They trailed Cincinnati 31-7 last week but rallied to make things interesting. Colorado backers suffered a tough beat last week at TCU. Coach Deion Sanders is dealing with a medical issue but should be on the sidelines here. We like Iowa State.

UTAH 28 Arizona State 24. Both teams come in off a bye. It's early but we think the winner here has the inside track to face Texas Tech in the Big 12 Championship game. Utah is 4-1 ATS on the season but the lone loss was at home to Texas Tech. Almost every Arizona State game has come down to the wire in recent weeks. Our ratings lean Arizona State and OVER. Check the weather forecast though as rain and chilly temps are expected.

BOISE STATE 37 New Mexico 20. Boise State led ND 7-6 in the second quarter last week but four second half interceptions did them in. New Mexico also had turnover issues last week as they fell at San Jose State. Our ratings lean under but we haven't gotten to the window yet.

USC 28 Michigan 27. These two faced each other in the Rose Bowl on eight different occasions (most common matchup) but now find themselves in the same conference. Michigan won in the final seconds last year 27-24. USC comes in off a bye as the Trojans suffered an upset loss at Illinois prior. USC is better in ypp margin but Michigan has played the tougher schedule. Probably the most important game in the Lincoln Riley era. We lean Michigan but need a "+3".

ARIZONA 26 BYU 25. BYU comes in at 5-0 but hasn't played the toughest slate of opponents. The same could be said for 4-1 Arizona. Both took care of arguably the two worst teams in the Big 12 last week (BYU 38-24 over West Virginia, Arizona 41-13 over Oklahoma State). We lean Arizona and the OVER.

TEXAS STATE 34 Troy 23. Texas State suffered yet another upset loss last week. This time 31-30 at Arkansas State as 14-point favorites. That's now 6 upset losses dating back to last season including four as a double-digit favorite. Unacceptable if this program wants to take the next step. Speaking of upsets, Troy is off back-to-back upset wins. We think they will be overmatched here. We like Texas State.

TENNESSEE 41 Arkansas 28. Nearly 15 years after being fired as Arkansas' head coach, Bobby Petrino is now the interim taking over for the fired Sam Pittman. Both teams come in off a bye. Arkansas' offense ranks No. 8 in the country averaging 515 ypg. Tennessee's ranks No. 6 averaging 536 ypg. The difference is Tennessee's defense is much better. Should be a fun one.

TEXAS A&M 27 Florida 20. Florida is coming off by far their best performance of the season as they upset Texas last week. True frosh WR Wilson made his debut and starred. Texas A&M is unbeaten but wasn't impressive as the 31-9 final indicated last week. They led Mississippi State 7-3 late in the third quarter. If we get the Florida of last week, the Gators could be live again.

LSU 28 South Carolina 17. Both teams come in off a bye. Both have struggled on offense this year. The Gamecocks average just 309 ypg (No. 127) while LSU rankings No. 119 in rushing offense. LSU is 19-1 in night home games under Brian Kelly. We like them here.

OHIO STATE 32 Illinois 17. The Buckeyes are No. 1 in the country in yards per play margin at +3.6. Their defense ranks No. 1 allowing just 5.0 points per game. QB Julian Sayin ranks No. 1 in the country completing 80.2 percent of his passes. Yet, the defending National Champs aren't getting a lot of publicity.

SMU 36 Stanford 18. SMU is 0-5 ATS failing to cover by 9.6 points per game. Yet, almost every week they get bet on. We're not fans of this Stanford team but the Cardinal have won a couple games in recent weeks and are playing with some confidence. Lean Stanford.

Nebraska 29 MARYLAND 22. Maryland led Washington 20-0 last week in the third quarter but lost. How does a young team respond? Nebraska is 4-1 and the Huskers rank in the Top 20 in ypp margin, ypg margin and scoring margin. Lean OVER.

Houston 31 OKLAHOMA STATE 17. Oklahoma State is by far the worst Power 4 team in the country. They have a skeleton staff. They've had several defensive players hit the transfer portal. They rank No. 135 in ypp margin at -2.3. Houston is off a humbling 35-11 loss to Texas Tech. QB Weigman was KO'd but just announced before press time, he will be available to play here.

UTSA 31 Rice 19. Rice comes in off an upset loss at home to FAU last week. Now they're back in their preferred underdog role. UTSA was also upset last week. The Roadrunners have been big disappointments so far this season. We didn't bet side or total.

Tcu 28 KANSAS STATE 27. Kansas State covered last week. However, we wonder what their frame of mind will be here after blowing a 31-17 second half lead at Baylor. At 2-4, they've already went UNDER their win total. TCU trailed Colorado 14-0 and were still tied at 21-21 in the fourth quarter. They hit a TD pass in the final seconds to give them the cover.

NOTRE DAME 42 NC State 19. Since starting 0-2, ND has reeled off 3 straight comfortable wins and their defense has allowed just 7 points the last 6 quarters after struggling for the first part of the season. NC State is playing a 7th straight week but is coming off an easy win over an FCS opponent. The Wolf Pack's offense is dangerous led by QB Bailey and RB Smothers. As of now, we're not involved.

OREGON 34 Indiana 24. Great matchup between two teams that rank in the Top 5 in yards per play margin, ypg margin and scoring margin. Oregon's upset win over Penn State did not age too well after the Nittany Lions lost to UCLA. Still, we trust them in this setting more than Indiana who just got by Iowa on the road and really struggled stepping up in class vs Ohio State and Notre Dame last season. Oregon is a big bet for us at "-7" or less.

Wake Forest 27 OREGON STATE 24. Tough spot for Wake Forest traveling all the way across the country after an upset win. Oregon State is much better than their 0-6 record indicates. Yes, they're also 1-5 ATS but they have suffered several close losses and last week got stopped inside the 10-yard line twice in a 4-point loss.

† **Texas 23 Oklahoma 20. @Cotton Bowl in Dallas, TX.** Obviously, the entire handicap revolves around the health status of Oklahoma QB John Mateer. There is some optimism that he can play here. Oklahoma's defense ranks No. 1 in ypp and No. 1 in total defense. They should really frustrate Texas QB Arch Manning who is coming off another disappointing performance. Our power ratings on page 5 and 6 reflect Mateer playing but not being close to 100%. We lean Texas which won't be a popular play in the markets.

UNLV 37 Air Force 30. UNLV is 5-0 but has played a weak strength of schedule and has had some fluky wins (outgained by Idaho State, 17-0 4Q at Miami, two blocked punt TD's at Wyoming). Air Force's offense has been great as they are No. 16 in yards per play. Their defense has been atrocious allowing 7.7 yards per play (dead last). Expect a lot of offense.

Utah State 30 HAWAII 28. Utah State is 5-0 ATS covering their games by an average of 12.3 points per game. They are +0.9 in ypp margin this year while Hawaii is -0.3 in ypp margin. Utah State has also played the tougher schedule. Easy to see why Utah State has flipped from dog to favorite in the last 24 hours. We're a part of it.

WYOMING 24 San Jose State 23. Wyoming had a misleading 14-point loss to UNLV last week where they had not one, but two block punts returned for TD's. San Jose State comes in off a much-needed win vs New Mexico. The two teams are close in the stats as San Jose is +0.2 in ypp margin while Wyoming is +0.0 and has played the tougher schedule. We lean with the home dog.

MINNESOTA 30 Purdue 21. The market bet Purdue from nearly a 2-TD underdog to a 7-point underdog last week. All the money fell short as they lost 43-27 to Illinois. They're taking on a Minnesota team that was humbled by Ohio State. Our power ratings say Minnesota but we haven't bet side or total.

Georgia 26 AUBURN 22. The spot says Auburn here as the Tigers come in off a bye. Meanwhile, Georgia is coming off their first cover of the season albeit it was only by a 0.5-point vs lowly Kentucky. Can Kirby Smart dial up any pressure here? The Bulldogs have only 7 sacks on the season but they're facing an Auburn team that has allowed 21 and has really struggled vs Oklahoma's and Texas A&M's defensive fronts. We need a Georgia "-3" to show to get involved.

San Diego State 24 NEVADA 17. Besides laying an egg vs Washington State in the final 35 minutes, San Diego State has played really well this year and are coming off 3 straight wins. Nevada has been better than their 1-4 record indicates as they've suffered 3 straight tough losses. We bet San Diego State on the openers but are passing at current.

Thursday, October 9th

Philadelphia 24 N.Y. GIANTS 16. The Eagles suffered their first loss of the season Sunday. They should feel fortunate to be 4-1 considering they rank No. 28 in yards per play margin. The 1-4 Giants rank No. 26 in that stat. The G-Men led New Orleans 14-3 but turnovers did them in highlighted by a 86-yard fumble return that went against them. Thursday nights are usually about the “Jimmy’s and Joe’s” and not the “X’s and O’s” with half a week. We like Philly in a teaser especially with a low total.

Sunday, October 12th

† **Denver 24 N.Y. Jets 17.** @Tottenham Hotspur Stadium in London, England. Denver comes in off the upset of Philadelphia where they outscored the Eagles 18-0 in the fourth quarter. The Broncos are a Top 10 team as they rank No. 7 in ypp margin, No. 7 in Sagarin and No. 10 in DVOA. Meanwhile, the Jets got bet to a favorite role vs a banged up Dallas team. It was worse than the 37-22 final as Dallas led 30-3. We’re passing.

PITTSBURGH 21 Cleveland 16. The stats say Cleveland is the play here. The Browns are -0.1 in yards per play margin despite playing the toughest schedule in the NFL so far. Meanwhile, Pittsburgh is No. 26 in ypp margin (-0.8) and has played the No. 22 schedule. However, the Steelers are off a bye. Cleveland returns from a trip overseas. Dillon Gabriel will get another start here as the Browns traded Joe Flacco this week. What a mess.

INDIANAPOLIS 26 Arizona 21. How does Arizona recover from one of the most embarrassing losses in franchise history? The Cardinals were up 21-6 and were going in for another score when RB Demercado inexcusably dropped the ball before crossing the goal line. Then Arizona fumbled after getting an interception and lost on the final play to the lowly Titans. Meanwhile, the Colts are 4-1 and coming off their most lopsided win in 12 years. Considering Indy was -7 at home to the lowly Raiders and are now laying the same number to the Cardinals, that screams this line isn’t cheap. Especially when the look-ahead line was -3.

L.A. Rams 26 BALTIMORE 19. The Ravens have given up more points so far through five games than they did their entire Super Bowl winning season of 2000 with one of the best defenses in NFL history. Baltimore is banged up again. Lamar Jackson is out again and they are 2-10 without him in recent years. Cooper Rush threw 3 INT’s. The Rams have extra time after an inexplicable loss to the 49ers last Thursday. The Rams had a 7.1-4.9 yards per play edge and a 91% post-game win expectancy. While we’re passing on side and total, we don’t mind the Rams in a teaser here.

Seattle 25 JACKSONVILLE 23. Jacksonville comes in off the dramatic MNF win over the Chiefs. Jacksonville only had a 22% post-game win expectancy and benefited from a 99-yard “Pick 6”. Meanwhile, Seattle is off a tough loss to Tampa Bay where they blew a late 4Q lead. The Seahawks had a 82% post-game win expectancy. Seattle is No. 2 in DVOA (advanced stat metric), the 2nd highest ever for a 3-2 team. We like them outright here.

Dallas 26 CAROLINA 23. Last week Dallas was missing four offensive line starters and WR Lamb. They were road underdogs at the lowly Jets. Yet, they led 30-3 at one point. They’re taking on a Carolina team that rallied from a 17-0 deficit vs Miami and picked up another surprising win. Dallas is 2-2-1 and has an appropriate +0.0 yards per play margin while playing an average schedule. Carolina -0.7 in ypp margin playing a below average schedule. Pass.

L.A. Chargers 24 MIAMI 20. The Chargers led the Commanders 10-0 after the first quarter but got outplayed big time after that in a 27-10 loss. They are having issues on the OL due to injury. However, we trust them here to bounce back much more than a gutless Miami team that blew a 17-0 lead vs Carolina last week. The Dolphins rank No. 29 in yards per play margin and No. 29 in the Sagarin ratings. Unacceptable for a team that had a 8.5-win total.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

TAMPA BAY 24 San Francisco 22. Both teams come in off improbable wins. The 49ers looked like they were “punting” on last Thursday’s game at the Rams. However, they won in OT as 8-point underdogs playing without several starters. They did have a -2.2 yards per play margin and just a 9% post-game win expectancy. Meanwhile, the Bucs pulled off some 4Q magic yet again rallying from behind vs Seattle. Both teams are +0.3 in ypp margin.

LAS VEGAS 22 Tennessee 18. Since week one, you can make a case that the Raiders have been the worst team in the NFL. They’re coming off yet another blowout loss. Meanwhile, the Titans got an improbable win rallying from a 21-6 4Q deficit to the Cardinals. It was more Arizona blowing it than Tennessee winning it. Las Vegas is just -0.2 in ypp margin while Tennessee continues to rank dead last at -1.9. Tough laying points with this Raiders offense though.

New England 24 NEW ORLEANS 21. Don’t look now but for the first time since 2019 (Brady’s last year), the Patriots have a winning record at the 5-game mark. New England pulled the big upset on SNF at Buffalo. Now they face a New Orleans team that just got their first win vs the Giants last week. Turnovers played a big role as the Saints forced five and got a critical 86-yard fumble return TD after trailing by double-digits early. Not sure we trust this New England team laying more than a FG on the road. We lean UNDER.

GREEN BAY 30 Cincinnati 15. How bad is Jake Browning? How about the Bengals trading for Joe Flacco on Tuesday and just announced before press-time, Flacco will get the start here. The Bengals were possibly a below-average team with Joe Burrow this year. Without him, they’re a bottom 2-3 team. Green Bay is coming off a bye after two inexplicable results vs Cleveland and Dallas. They can name their score if they want.

KANSAS CITY 29 Detroit 26. A great matchup for SNF. The Chiefs are desperate at 2-3 and coming off a last second loss to the Jaguars on MNF. It should have been a win as they had a 476-319 yard edge and also a 7.6-5.9 yards per play edge. The key play being a 99-yard “Pick 6” for Jacksonville. On the other side, Detroit enters on a 4-game win and cover streak. The Lions rank No. 1 in DVOA but are dealing with more injuries again. We lean with KC but could see using Detroit in a teaser.

Monday, October 13th

Buffalo 26 ATLANTA 24. Buffalo is off the SNF upset loss to the Patriots that ended their unbeaten season. It’s the first time since 2014, that no NFL team has started 5-0. The Bills rank No. 9 in ypp margin at +0.7. The Falcons fresh off a bye actually rank No. 5 in that category with a +0.8 mark. Atlanta has also played the much tougher schedule than Buffalo (No. 9 vs No. 32). We think the Falcons could be live here.

WASHINGTON 27 Chicago 21. Jayden Daniels returned last week for the Commanders and Washington got a big win at the Chargers 27-10 after trailing 10-0 early. They’re taking on the Bears who are coming off a bye. Chicago is 2-2 but the Bears are -1.4 in yards per play margin ranking No. 30. Washington is +0.4 while also ranking No. 5 in Sagarin and No. 5 in DVOA. We lean with the home team here.
