## Shabbat Chazon Guidelines

- You can still make early Shabbat and eat meat and drink wine at the Shabbat meal.
- Wine may be used for Havdallah and drunk by an adult. Some have the practice of giving the wine to a child or using beer.

## Shabbat Schedule for Home

### Friday

**6:49pm** – Plag HaMincha

- Those accepting Shabbat at Plag HaMincha must complete Mincha before 6:49pm and can daven Ma'ariv after 6:49pm

**7:00pm** – Mincha / Kabbalat Shabbat

- Families who daven Mincha at 7:00pm should light candles by 7:15pm

**8:01pm** – Candle Lighting

**8:05pm** – Mincha / Kabbalat Shabbat

- The bracha "Me'ein sheva" (including Magen Avot) is omitted when davening alone; Vayichulu is said, followed by Aleinu

### Shabbat

**Shacharit** – You may want to daven Shacharit at the same time that you typically do on Shabbat, or say the Amida of Shacharit at Netz, which is 5:46am

**9:24am** – Latest Shma

- Brich Shmei is not recited when davening alone
- Only the first paragraph of Yikum Purkan is recited when davening alone

**1:38pm** – Earliest Mincha

- Rabbi Baum will recite the Keil Maleh prayer for those observing yartzeit from 4 – 10 Av

**8:18pm** – Sunset (finish Mincha before sunset)

**9:00pm** – Ma'ariv

**9:06pm** – Shabbat ends

## Guidelines for Sunday through Wednesday, July 26 – July 29

**Mincha:** Earliest times to daven Mincha

- Sunday, July 26, through Wednesday, July 29 – 1:38pm

**Sunset:** Finish davening Mincha before sunset

- Sunday and Monday – 8:17pm; Tuesday – 8:16pm; Wednesday – 8:15pm

**Ma'ariv:** Daven Ma'ariv after sunset

Additional capacity will be available for all minyanim in the Shul tent on Tisha B'Av; registration information to follow.

Erev Tisha B'Av, Wednesday, July 29: Mincha – 6:00pm Ma'ariv & Eicha – 8:25pm

Tisha B'Av, Thursday, July 30: Shacharit – 8:15am Mincha – 2:45pm Ma'ariv – 8:40pm

## Wednesday, July 29: Erev Tisha B'Av & Tisha B'Av Evening

**ArtScroll Kinot books are available for pickup outside of the Shul for anyone who would like to have them to help prepare for or to use on Tisha B'Av. There is no charge, and they do not have to be returned.**

- No Tachanun at Mincha
- Seudah Hamafseket – At the concluding meal before the fast, we make hamotzi, and eat an egg dipped into ashes to symbolize our state of mourning. Eating and drinking should stop before sunset (8:15pm).
- Ma'ariv – After 8:15pm, followed by Eicha, which can be read at home. Ve'Atah Kadosh is said followed by Aleinu.

### Eicha LIVE Broadcast

There will be a live broadcast of Eicha from the shul outdoor minyan beginning with Maariv at 8:25pm. A few of Kinot will follow Eicha.

## Thursday, July 30: Tisha B'Av

- Shacharit - Tefillin and Talit are not worn.
- The Shir shel Yom is not said until Mincha.

### Kinot with Rabbi Baum

9:30 – approximately 11:15am – Rabbi Baum will lead selected Kinot via Zoom

We will distribute a list of Kinot that will be said, and this list can be used if you choose to say the Kinot on your own.

Kinot can be said any time of the day, ideally concluded by Chatzot. If you are joining the Zoom Kinot, you can complete Shacharit with Ashrei, Uva L'Tzion and Aleinu before the Kinot. If not, Kinot are said following the Haftora, or, if you are home, following the Amida.

- 1:02pm – Chatzot – You can sit on a regular chair after this time.
- Mincha after 1:40pm and before sunset at 8:13pm.
  - Tallit and tefillin are worn at Mincha. The Shir shel Yom is recited, followed by Ashrei and the Torah reading & Haftora for a Fast Day if you are at a minyan. Shemona Esrei including Nachem (even if you are not fasting) and Aneinu (if you are fasting) and Sim Shalom (if you are fasting). Mincha concludes with Aleinu.

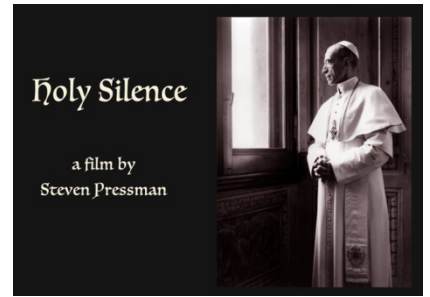


## Film
