Anna Gerow, 94, a native of the Western Thumb and longtime Sebawaing resident, died Saturday, August 21, in St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Mt. Clemens, following a brief illness.

She was born April 8, 1899, in Linkville, the daughter of Jacob and Emma (Burke) Kain. She was married to John (Jack) Gerow in Detroit in 1931. The Gerows owned and operated Gerow's Tavern, now Sporty's Bar in Sebawaing, for 25 years before retiring in 1950. Mr. Gerow preceded her in death in 1967. She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church of Sebawaing.

Surviving are one son and daughter-in-law, Dale J. and Donna Gerow of New Haven, one granddaughter, Julie (Duane) Crawford of Rochester Hills, one great-grandson, Cameron Crawford, and several nieces and nephews.

One sister, Dora Kelly, and five brothers, Jacob, Wesley, Norman, Frank and Samuel Kain, all preceded her in death.

The funeral service will take place at 1:30 pm Tuesday (today) in Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home, Sebawaing. Rev. Lawrence C. Brooks will officiate and burial will be in Silvertown Cemetery, Sebawaing.

There will be visitation at the funeral home from 9 am today until the time of service.
