

Coconut Cake



Bake a white (or vanilla) box cake mix according to package directions in a 9 X 13 pan.

When you remove it from the oven, and while it's still hot/warm, use a wooden spoon handle to poke holes into the cake, spaced about an inch apart.

Open a can of cream of coconut, stir well to mix it up; pour cream of coconut onto the top of the cake, letting it run down into the holes.

Let cake cool completely.

Spread one 8-9 oz. container of Cool Whip (or non-dairy whipped topping) over the cake, like frosting.

Sprinkle about a cup of sweetened coconut on top.

Keep refrigerated. Yummy!

That's going to take a good attitude, putting the best construction on things, and your help and contribution to make this journey forward possible. It is going to take your continued prayers and financial offerings to support our regular budget and continued restorations. It's not going to be the same for a long time. Prepare for that. But maybe this is a good thing. Perhaps in the midst of this devastation the Lord will do something we do not expect for our good and the greater good for the people of Hawarden. Maybe this is a greater opportunity for more and others not yet present to be glad in the Lord and His house. "I was glad when they said unto me, let us go to the house of the Lord."

It was not the summer we expected it to be. The flood that devastated our community changed our expectations beyond anything many of us could imagine. Many people in our community suffered the complete or partial loss of their homes, businesses were destroyed and displaced, and our beloved church and parsonage suffered extensive loss.

First of all, this is the first time as a pastor that I have experienced such a loss personally, while having our building, and many of our members lives impacted so drastically. I confess there were times I did not say and do the things people might have expected me to say and do. I am grieving our personal loss, while trying to navigate church cleanup and restoration, and pastorally caring for those in our congregation. I ask forgiveness from those who encountered something from me that offended them.

Second, it is clear that God wants Trinity to stay in Hawarden. When the waters flooded many of you showed up to clean out the parsonage and church basement. We were blessed to have numerous non-members be part of this great clean-up effort. God's people and congregations throughout the LCMS has generously offered their prayers and sent their gifts to the tune of over \$100,000. The LCMS disaster response teams from six districts, lowa West, lowa East, South Dakota, Missouri, Nebraska and Minnesota North, have faithfully came and provided help restoring the parsonage and cleaning out the church basement. All thanks and praise to our generous Father!


