As a special treat Mrs Cathy is brining donuts for the snack bar on Thursday 10/28th.






Don't forget to set your clock back an hour on Saturday, **November 7th**, before you go to bed. You don't want to be late to Mass on Sunday.

3. Please send a note to your child's teacher (grades K – 4th especially) as we are beginning the year. Sometimes the younger students don't know if they are eating hot lunch or a lunch from home!
